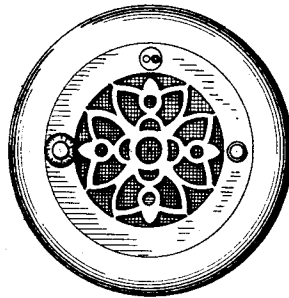

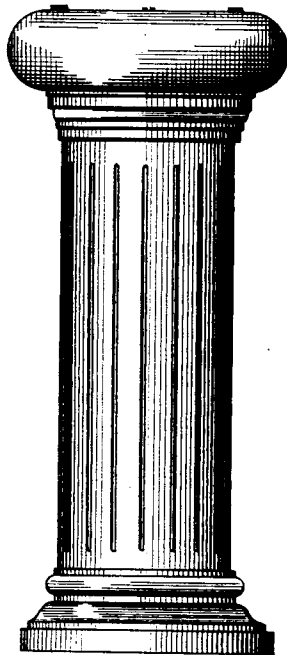

MAX C. WHITMORE, OF CHICAGO, ILLINOIS.

DESIGN FOR A RADIOCABINET.

Application filed August 8, 1928. Serial No. 27,747. Term of patent  $3\frac{1}{2}$  years.

*To all whom it may concern:*

Be it known that I, MAX C. WHITMORE, a citizen of the United States, residing at Chicago, in the county of Cook and State of Illinois, have invented a new, original, and ornamental Design for Radio Cabinet, of which the following is a specification, reference being had to the accompanying drawing, forming a part thereof.

Figure 1 is a top plan view of a radio cabinet showing the design of my invention; and Fig. 2 is a front elevational view of Fig. 1.
