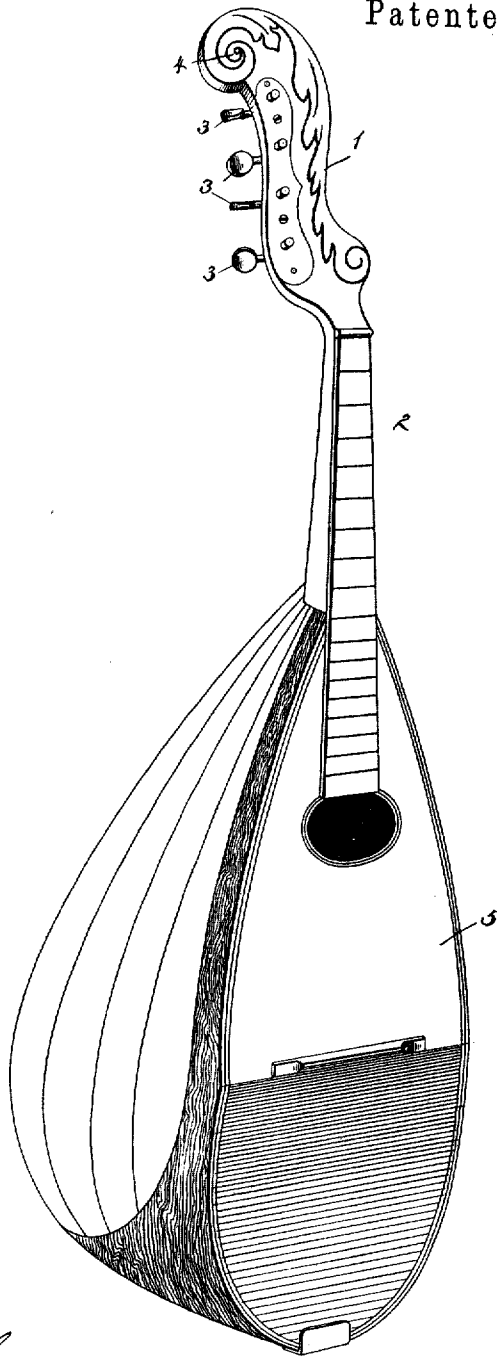

DESIGN FOR A MANDOLIN.

SPECIFICATION forming part of Design No. 28,340, dated March 8, 1898.

Application filed October 27, 1897. Serial No. 656,590. Term of patent 7 years.

To all whom it may concern:

Be it known that I, EUGENE B. BAEHR, a citizen of the United States, residing at New York city, in the county and State of New York, have invented and produced a new and original Design for a Mandolin, of which the following is a specification, reference being had to the accompanying drawing, forming a part thereof.

10 The leading feature of my design consists of the head of the neck arranged in such a manner with respect to the neck that its opposite side edges will be approximately parallel and at an angle trending laterally of the
15 neck.

Minor features of the design consist in the laterally-extended scroll at end of the head and the keys all projected from one side of the head.

In the drawing, 1 is the head; 2, the neck; 20 3, the keys; 4, the scroll, and 5 the mandolin-shaped body.

I claim—

The design for a mandolin, herein shown and described.
