(57) **CLAIM**


The ornamental design for a console for a laundry appliance,
as shown and described.

DESCRIPTION

FIG. 1 is a perspective view of a console for a laundry
appliance according to my design;
FIG. 2 is a top plan view of the console;
FIG. 3 is a front elevational view of the console;
FIG. 4 is a rear elevational view of the console;
FIG. 5 is a left side elevational view of the console;
FIG. 6 is a right side elevational view of the console; and,
FIG. 7 is an enlarged top plan view of the console.

In each of the Figures, the console is shown positioned on
a broken line representation of a laundry appliance which is
for illustrative purposes only and forms no portion of the
claimed invention.






