

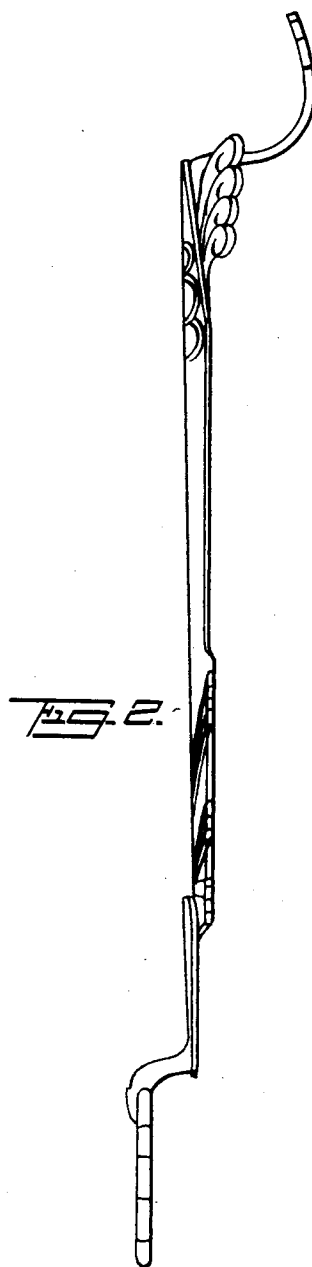
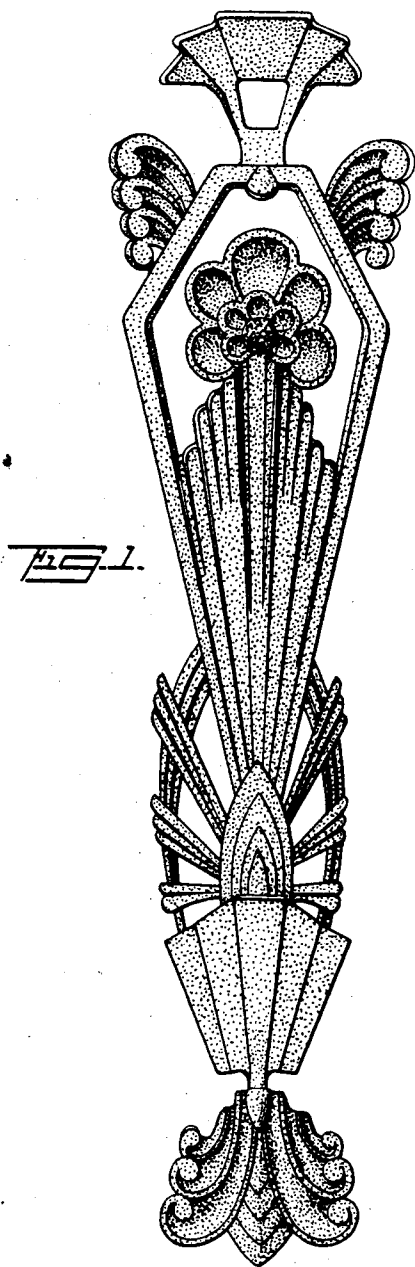

DESIGN FOR A LIGHTING-FIXTURE STREAMER OR ARTICLE OF ANALOGOUS NATURE

To all whom it may concern:

Be it known that I, MARTIN S. ROTELLINI, a subject of the King of Italy, and a resident of the borough of Brooklyn, county of Kings, and State of New York, have invented a new, original, and ornamental Design for a Lighting-Fixture Streamer or Article of Analogous Nature, of which the following is a specification, reference being had to the accompanying drawing, forming a part thereof.

Figure 1 is a front elevational view of the lighting fixture streamer or article of analogous nature.

Figure 2 is a diagrammatic side outline view of the same.
