CLAIM

The ornamental design for a scratch brush handle, as shown and described.

DESCRIPTION

FIG. 1 is a side elevational view of a scratch brush handle embodying our new design, the opposite side being a mirror

FIG. 2 is a top plan view thereof;

FIG. 3 is a bottom plan view thereof;

FIG. 4 is an end elevational view thereof as seen from the left of FIG. 1;

FIG. 5 is a cross sectional view taken on line 5—5 of FIG. **2**; and,

FIG. 6 is a cross sectional view taken on line 6—6 of FIG.

The broken line showing of brush bristles in the drawing is for illustrative purposes only and forms no part of the claimed design.
