DESCRIPTION

FIG. 1 is a front perspective view of a new, ornamental design for a hinged, convertible greenhouse in a fully closed position;

FIG. 2 is a front perspective view of a new, ornamental design for a hinged, convertible greenhouse in a partially open position;

FIG. 3 is a front perspective view of a new, ornamental design for a hinged, convertible greenhouse in a fully open position; FIG. 4 is a first end elevation view of the hinged, convertible greenhouse as shown in FIG. 1;

FIG. 5 is a second end elevation view of the greenhouse as shown in FIG. 1;

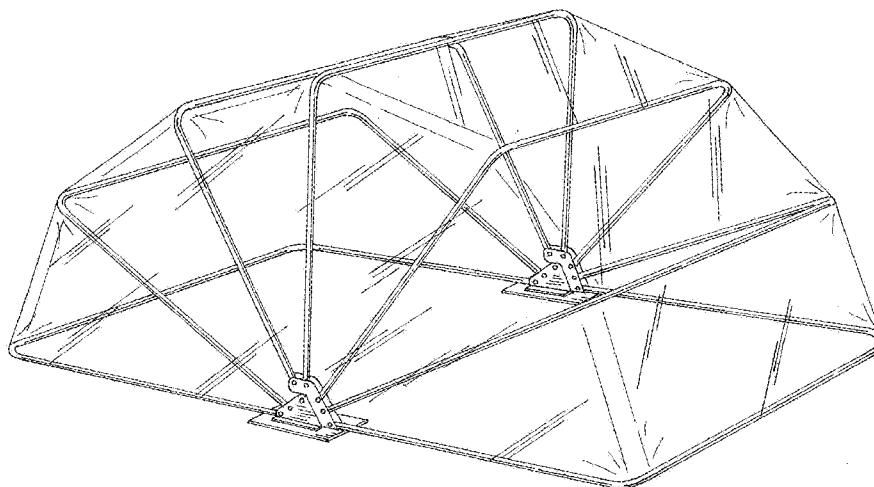
FIG. 6 is a rear elevation view of the hinged, convertible greenhouse as shown in FIG. 1;

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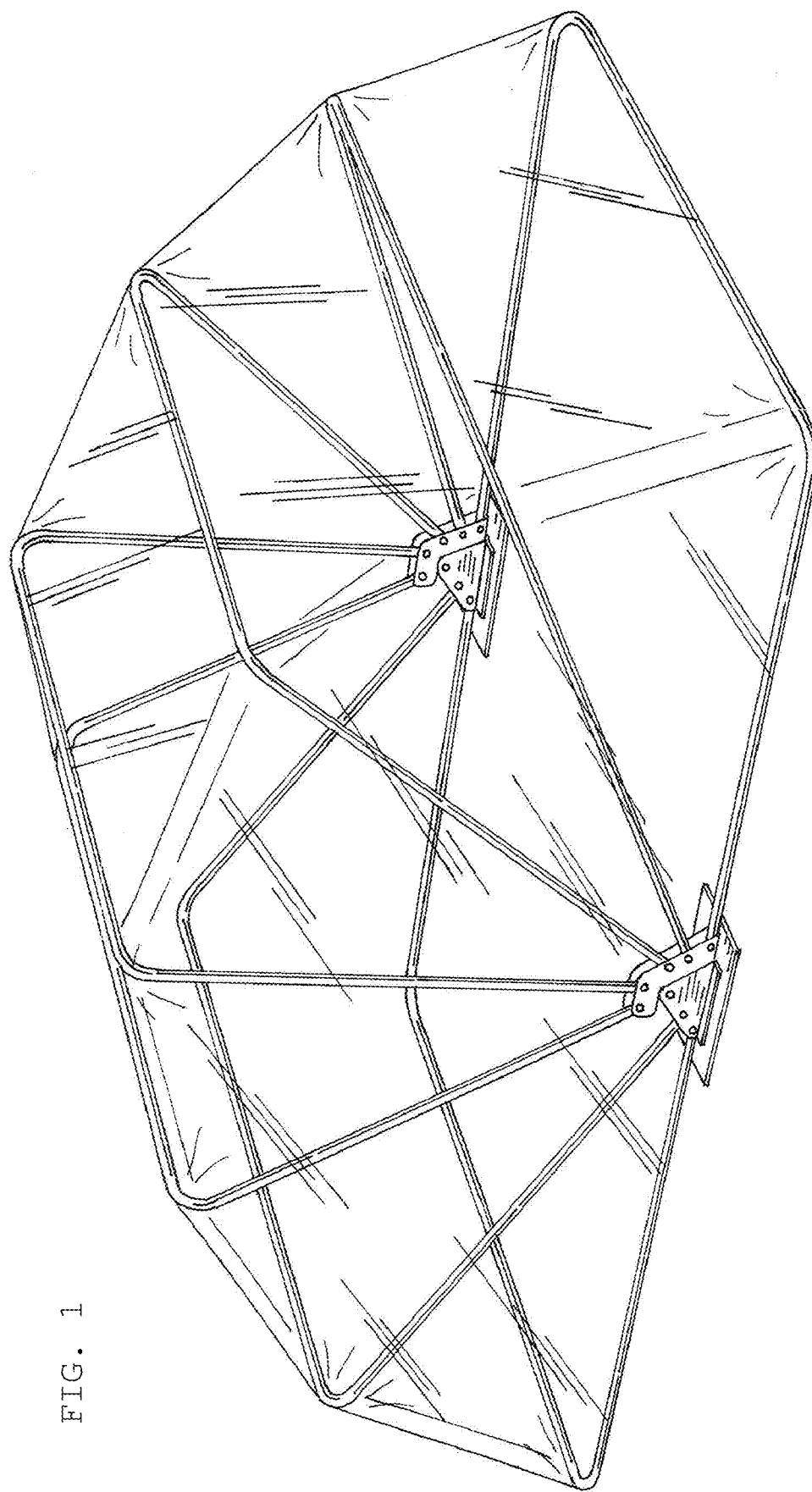

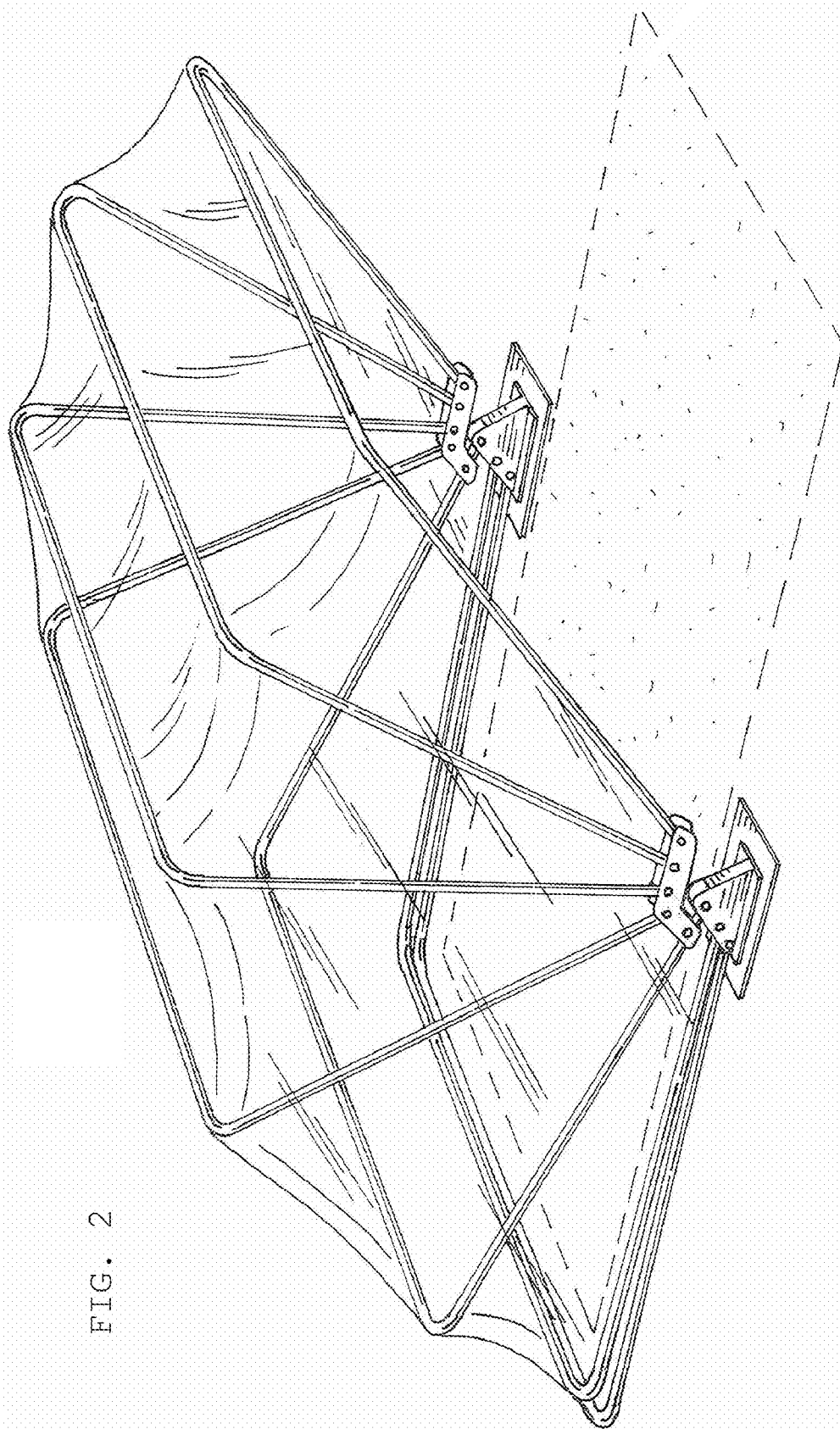
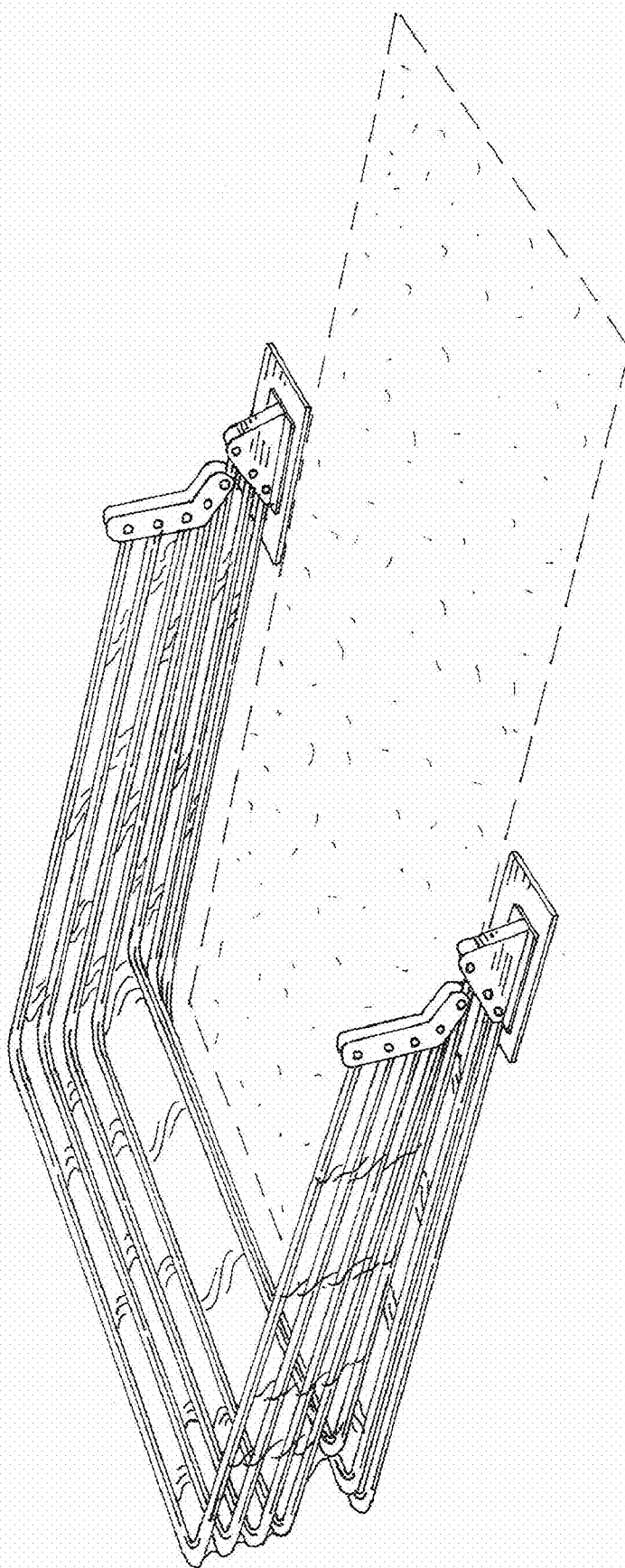

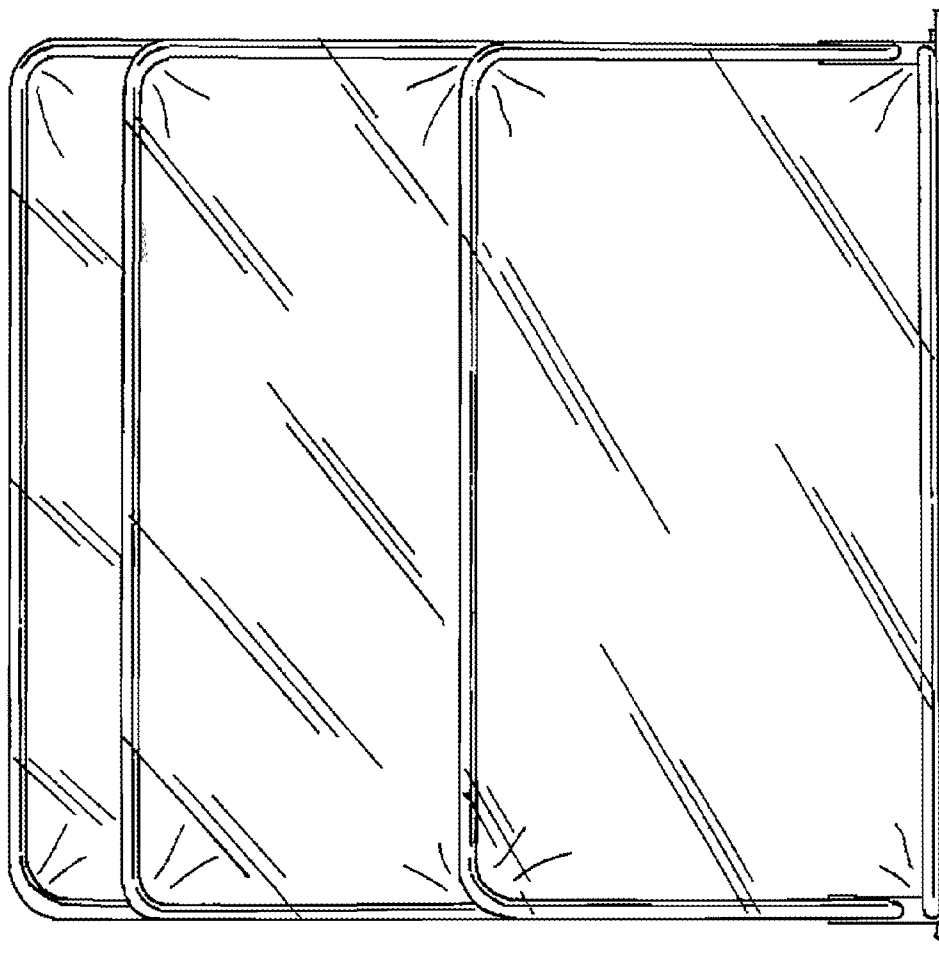

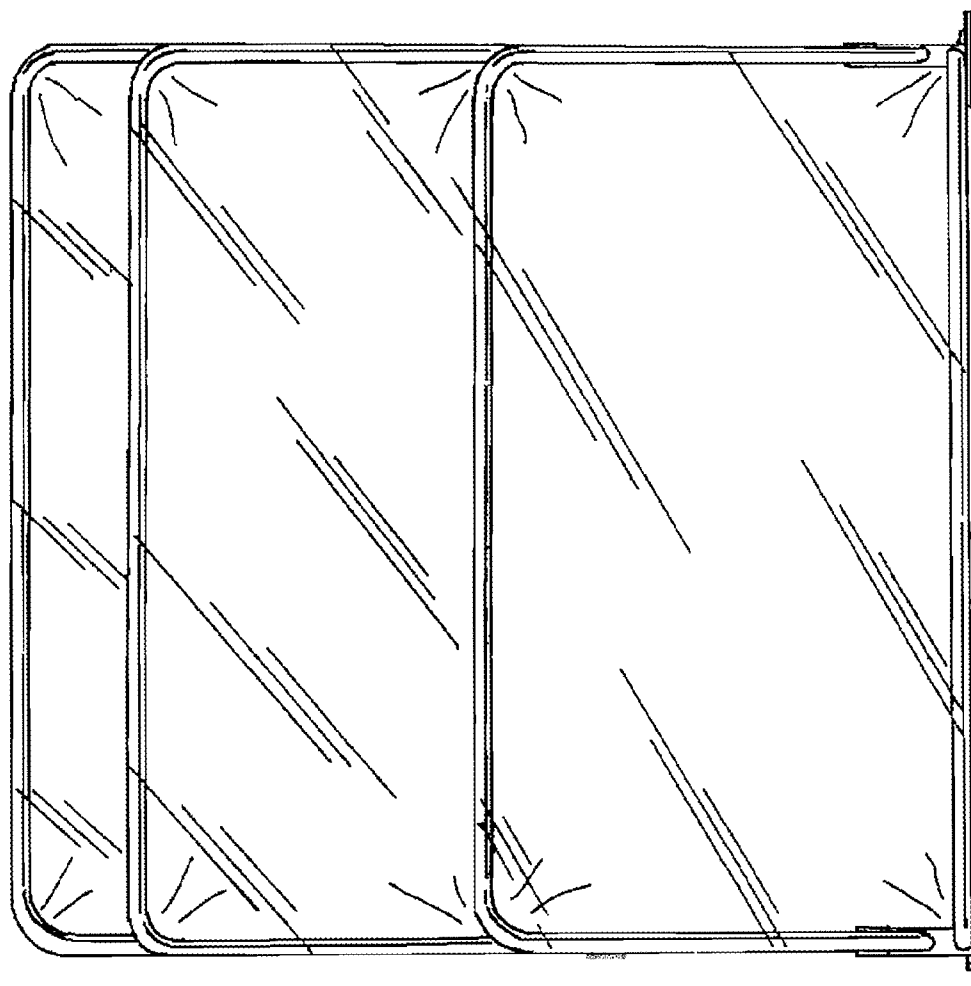

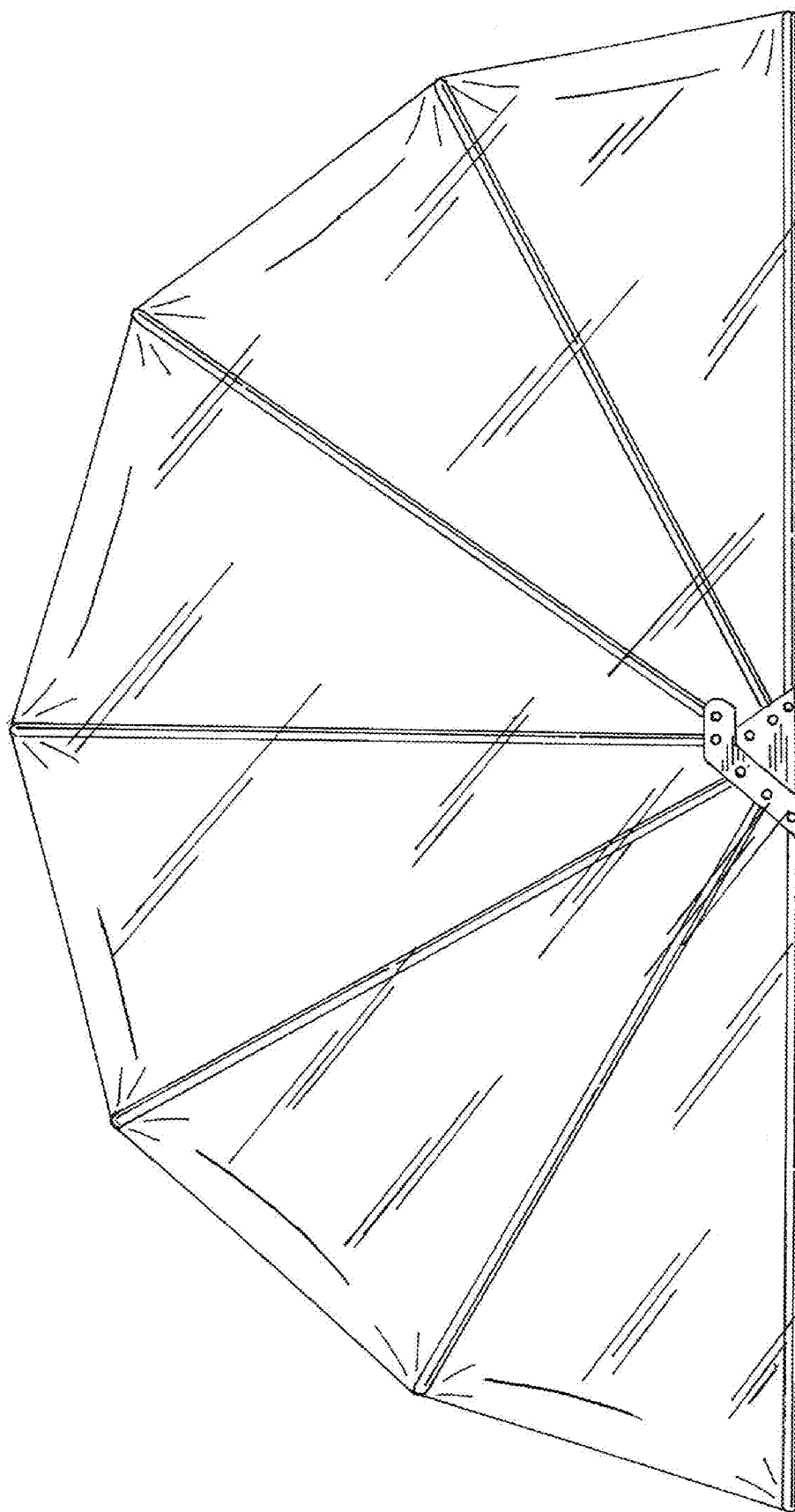

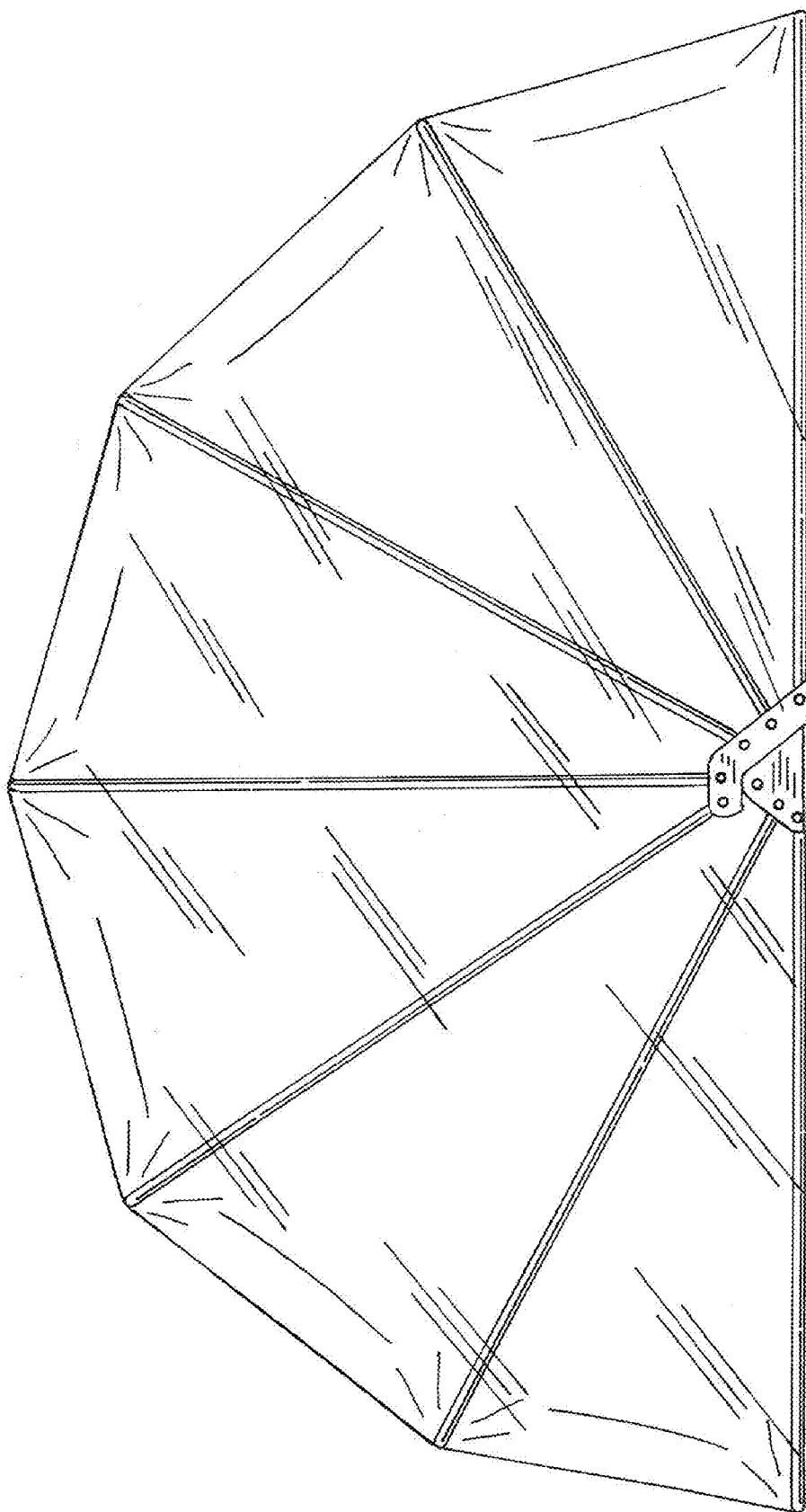

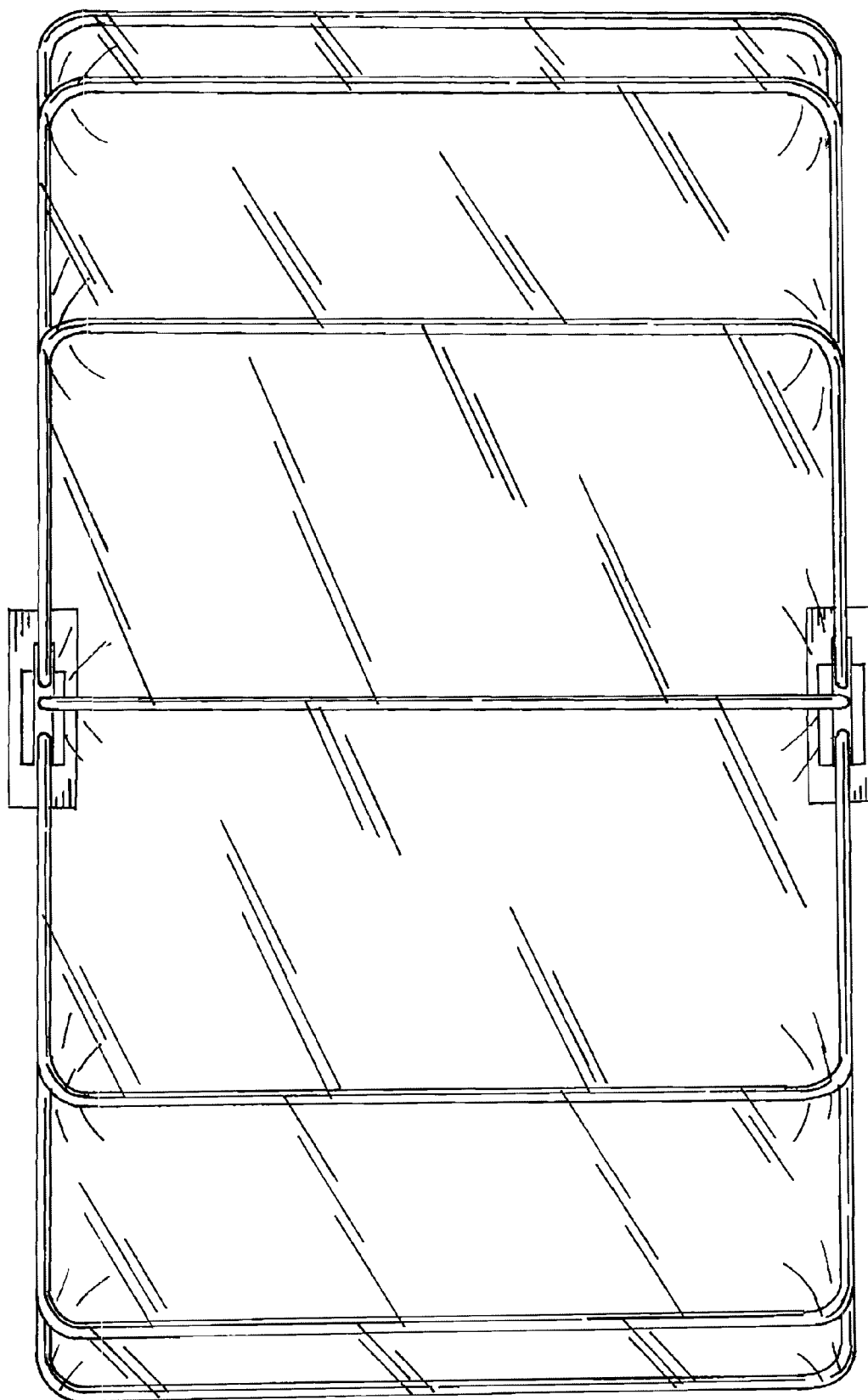
