DESCRIPTION

FIG. 5 is a left view thereof;

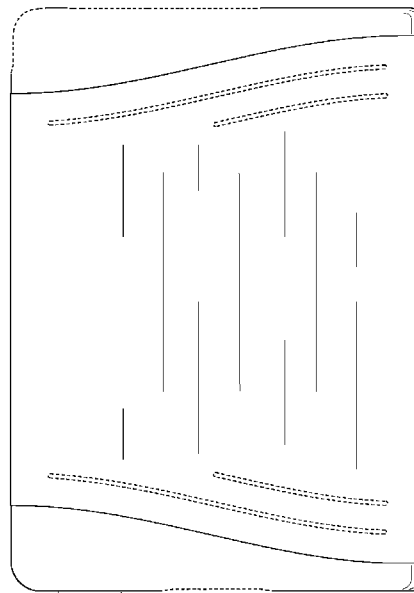
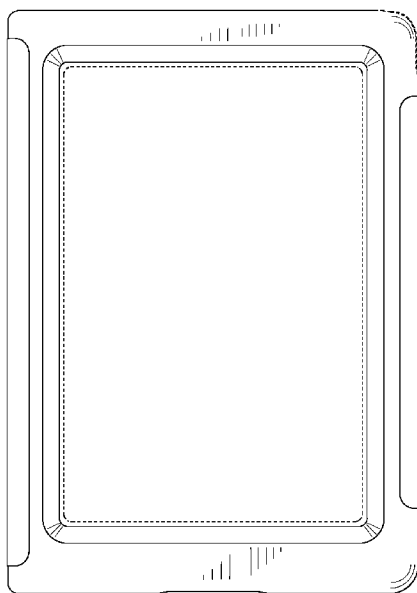
FIG. 6 is a right view thereof;

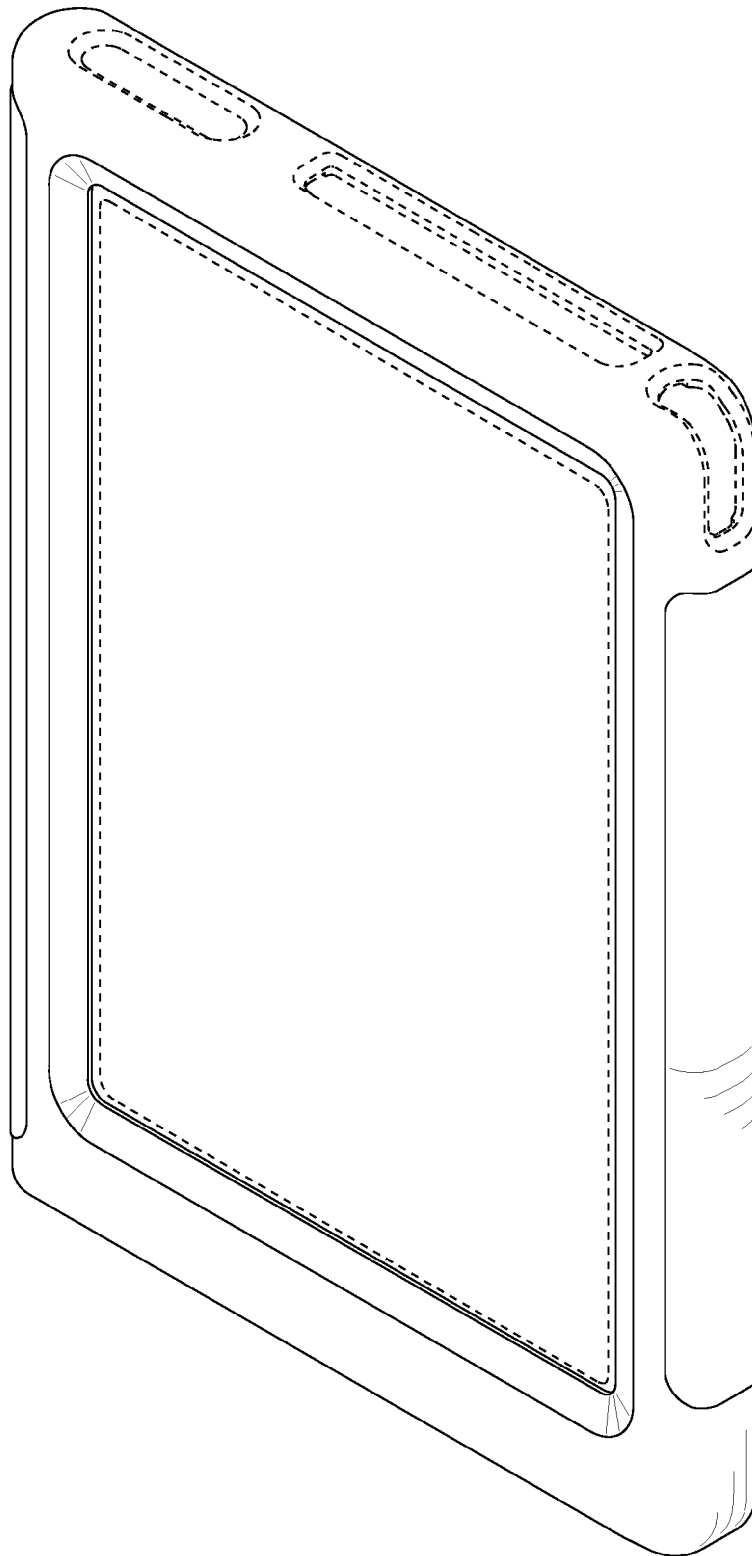

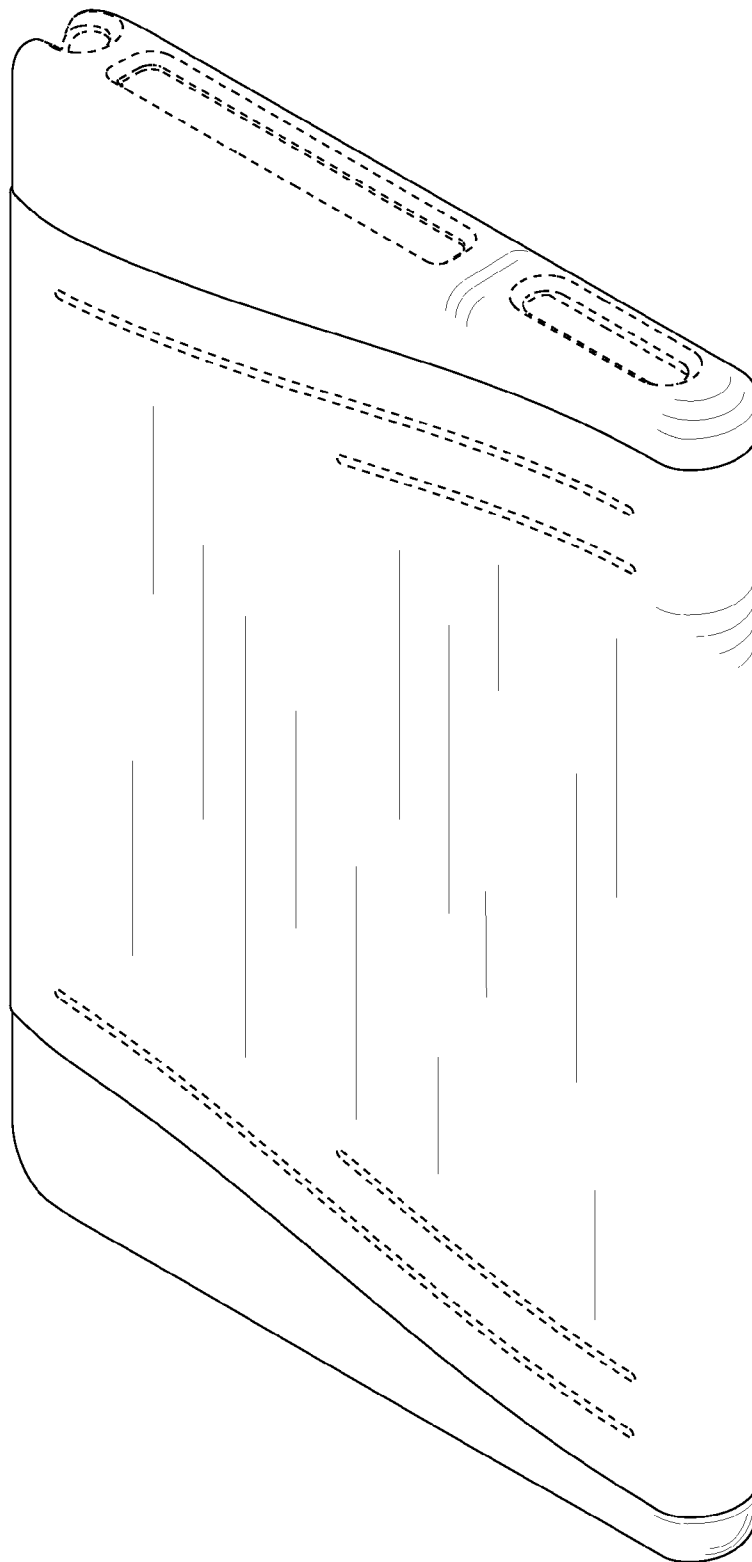

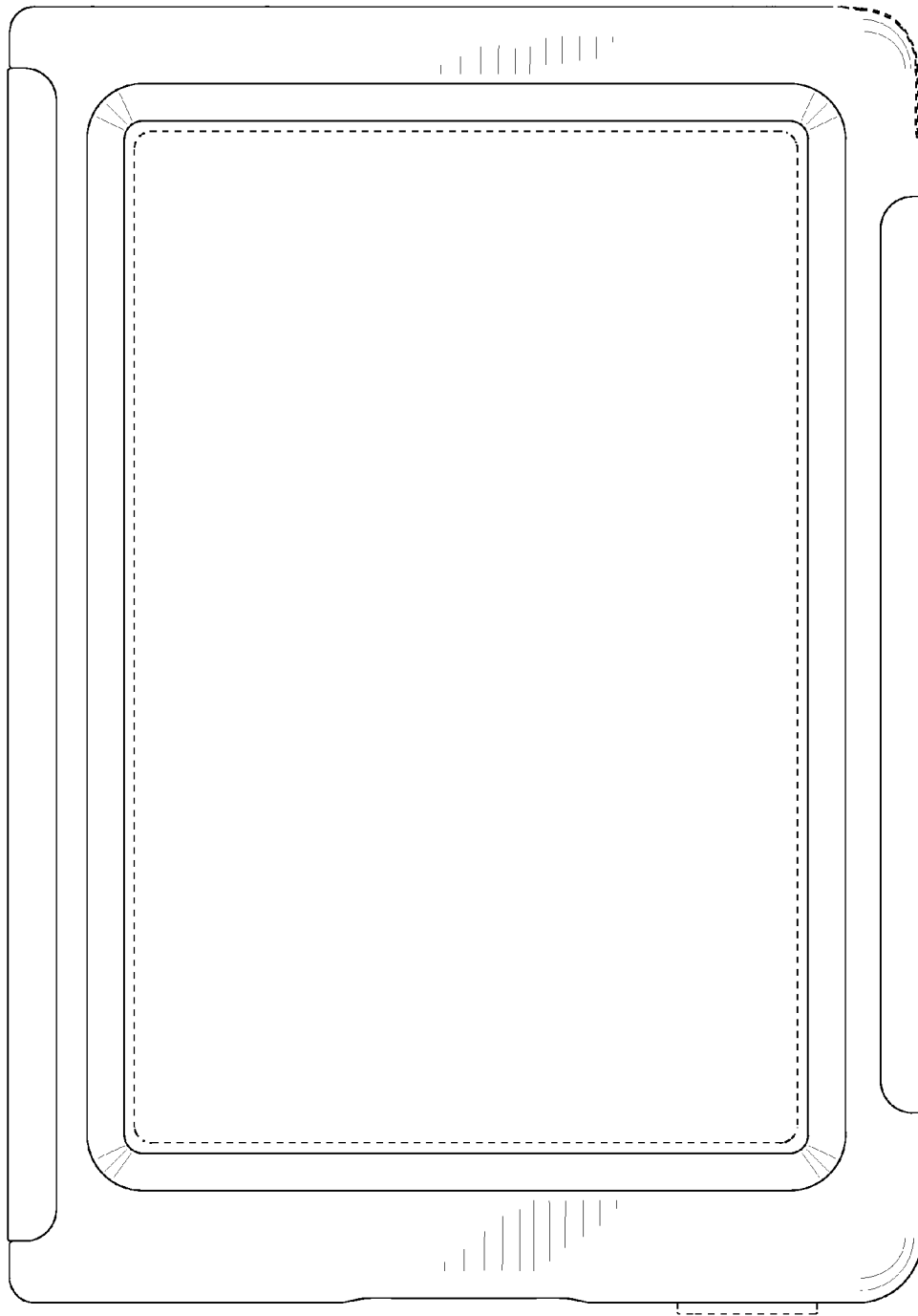

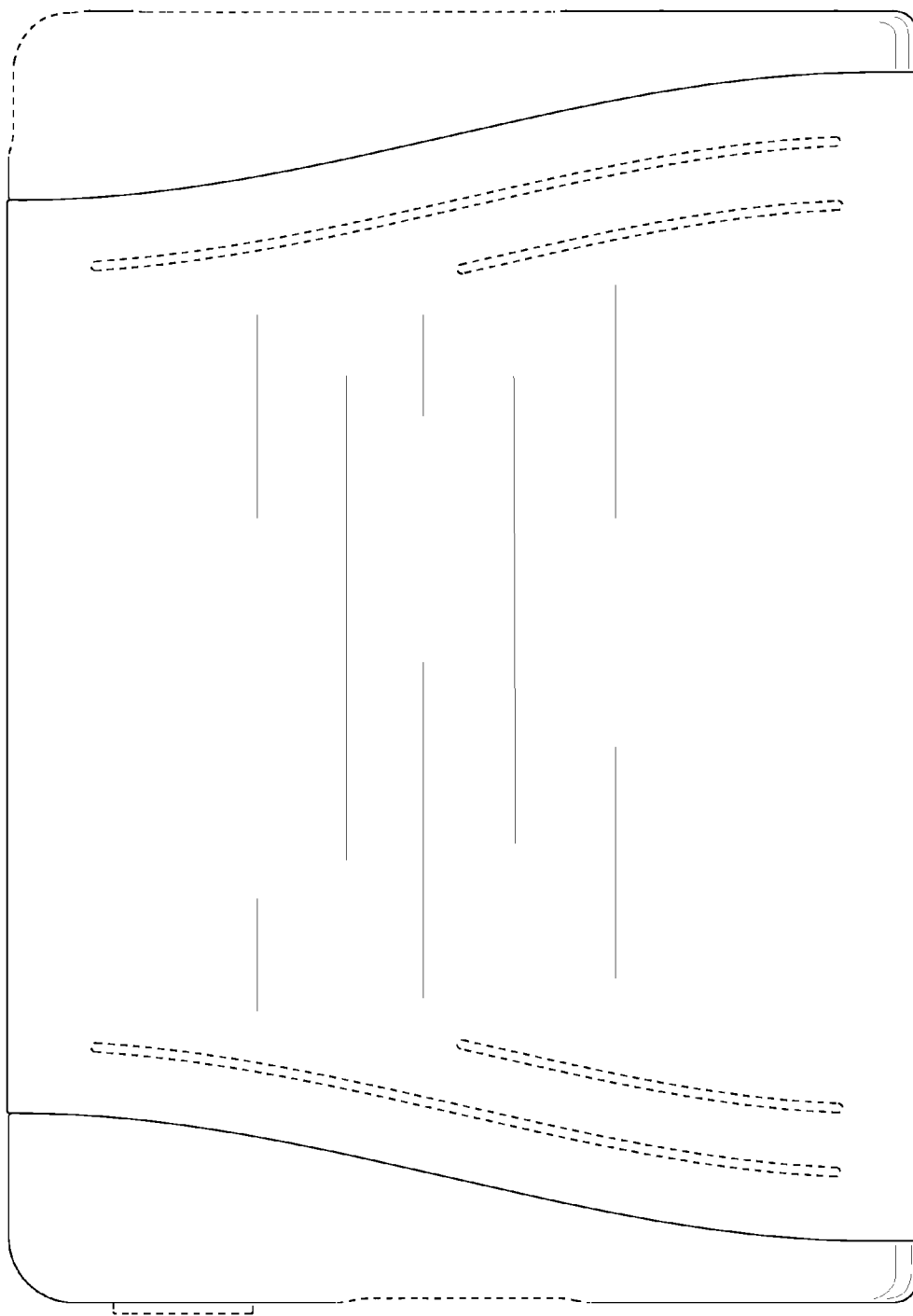

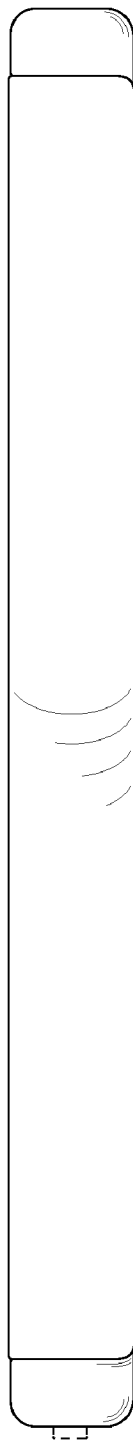

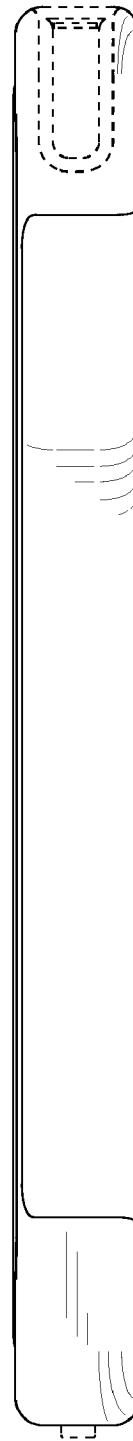

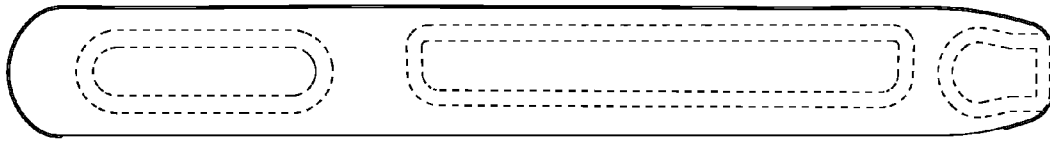
