(57) **CLAIM**


The ornamental design for a shoe, as shown and described.

**DESCRIPTION**

FIG. 1 is a front perspective view of a shoe showing our new design;  
FIG. 2 is a side view thereof; and,  
FIG. 3 is a rear perspective view thereof.  
The broken line immediately adjacent to the top of the shaded area on the stripe defines a bound of the claimed design and forms no part thereof. The broken lines depicting the remainder of the shoe show features that form no part of the claimed design.






