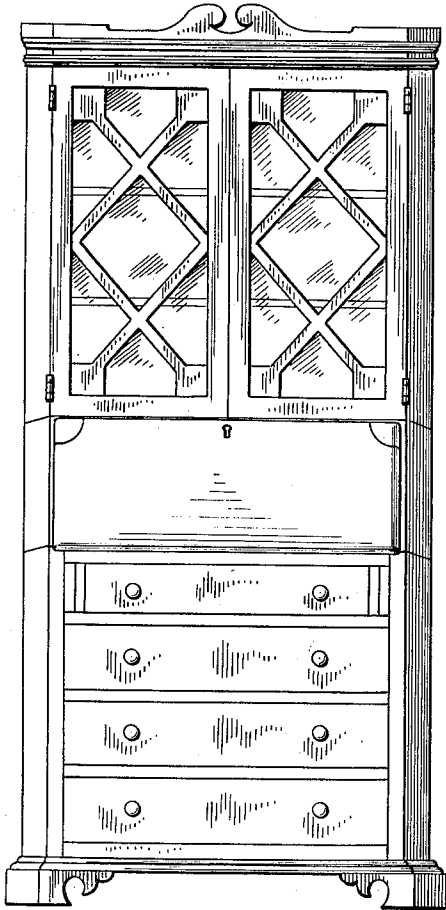

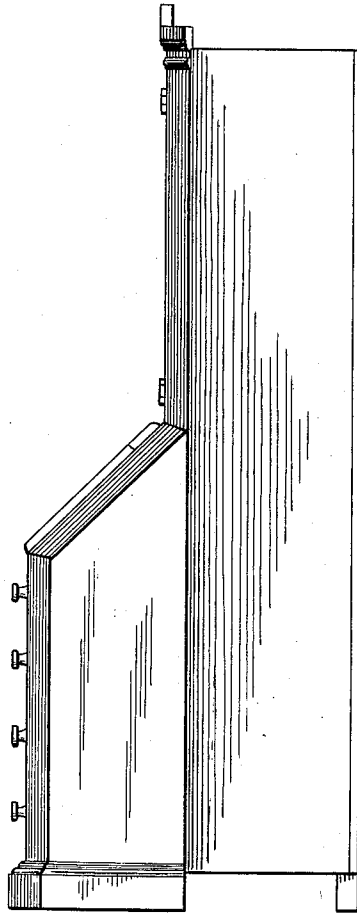

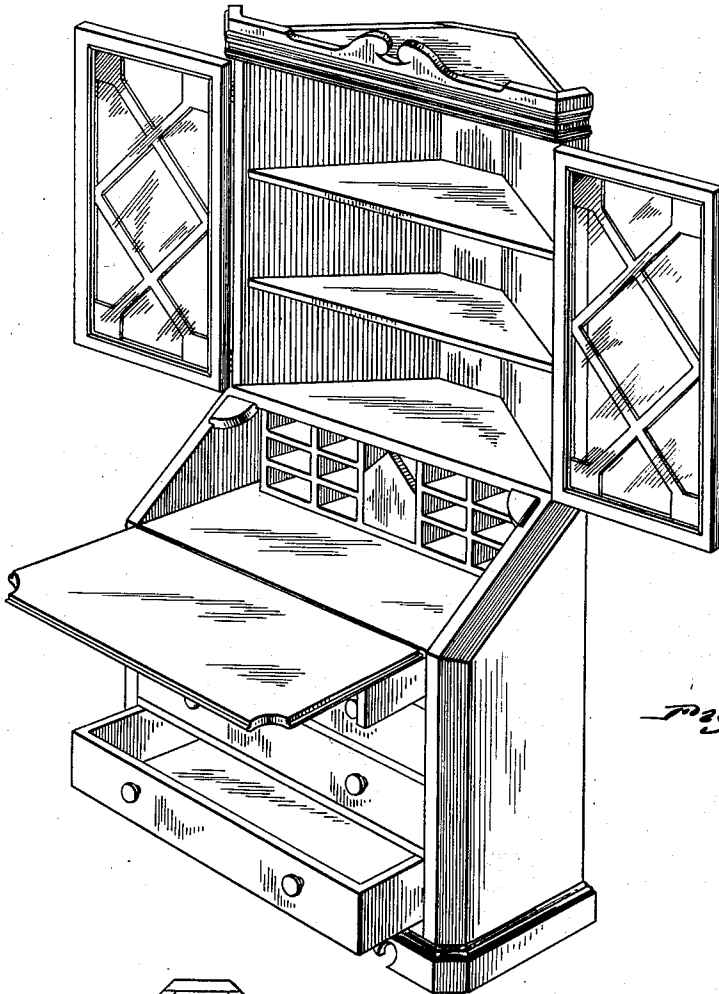

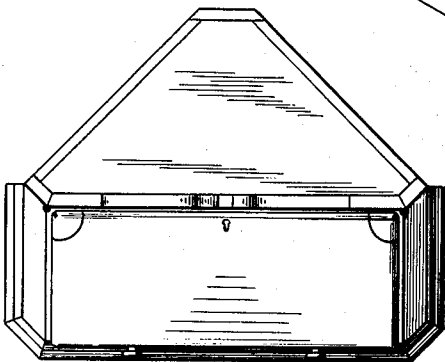

Be it known that I, Mack E. Garner, a citizen of the United States, residing at Newport News, in the county of Warwick and State of Virginia, have invented a new, original, and ornamental Design for a Corner Secretary or the Like, of which the following is a specification, reference being had to the accompanying drawings, forming part thereof.
