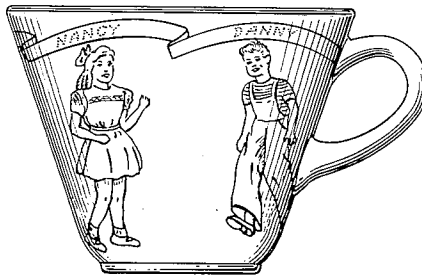

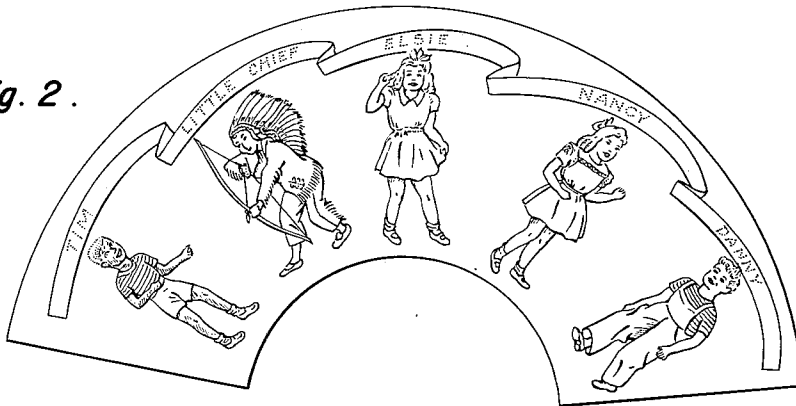
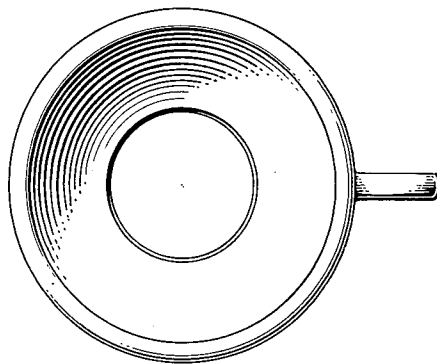

To all whom it may concern:

Be it known that I, Emma C. Hense, a citizen of the United States, residing at Centralia, in the county of Lewis and State of Washington, have invented a new, original, and ornamental Design for a Cup, of which the following is a specification, reference being had to the accompanying drawing, forming part thereof.

Figure 1 is a side elevational view of a cup, showing my new design;

Figure 2 is a developed plan view of the outer surface of the cup; and

Figure 3 is a top plan view thereof.
