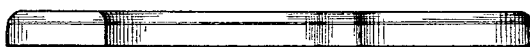

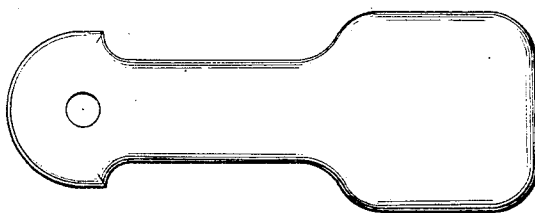

*To all whom it may concern:*

Be it known that I, CLARENCE W. WHITE, a citizen of the United States of America, residing in North Bennington, county of Bennington, and State of Vermont, have invented a new, original, and ornamental Design for a Seat-Body for Children's Vehicles, of which the following is a specification, reference being had to the accompanying drawing, forming part thereof.
