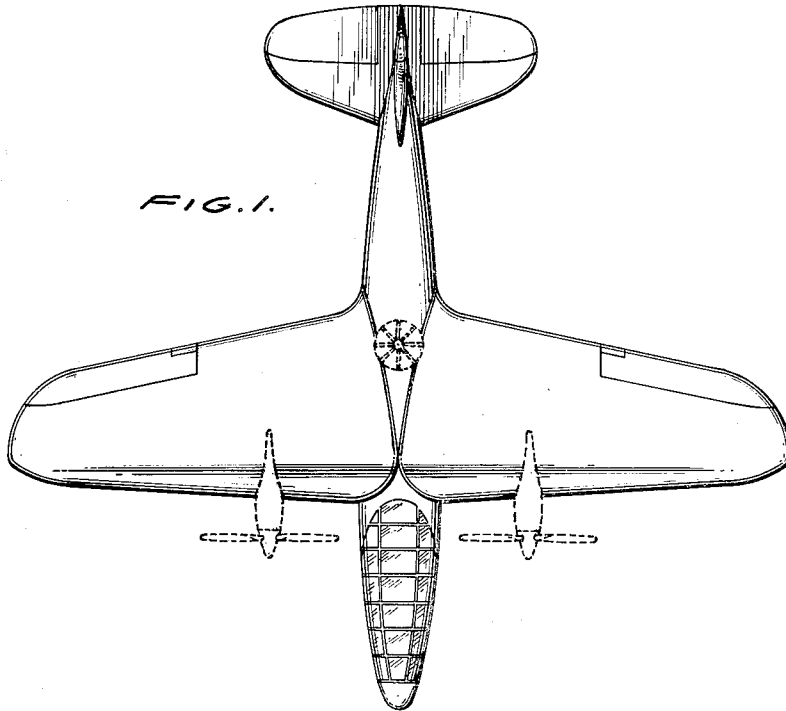

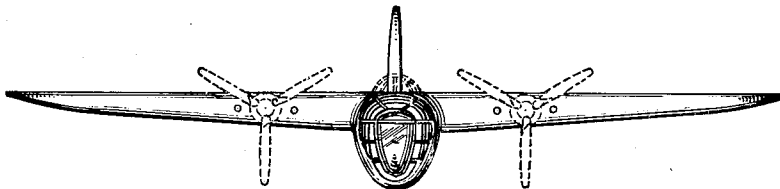
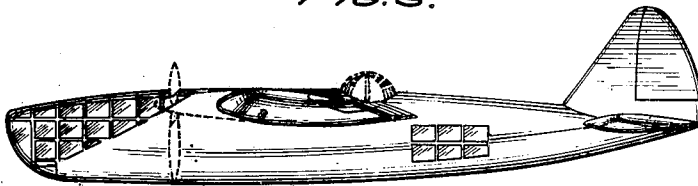

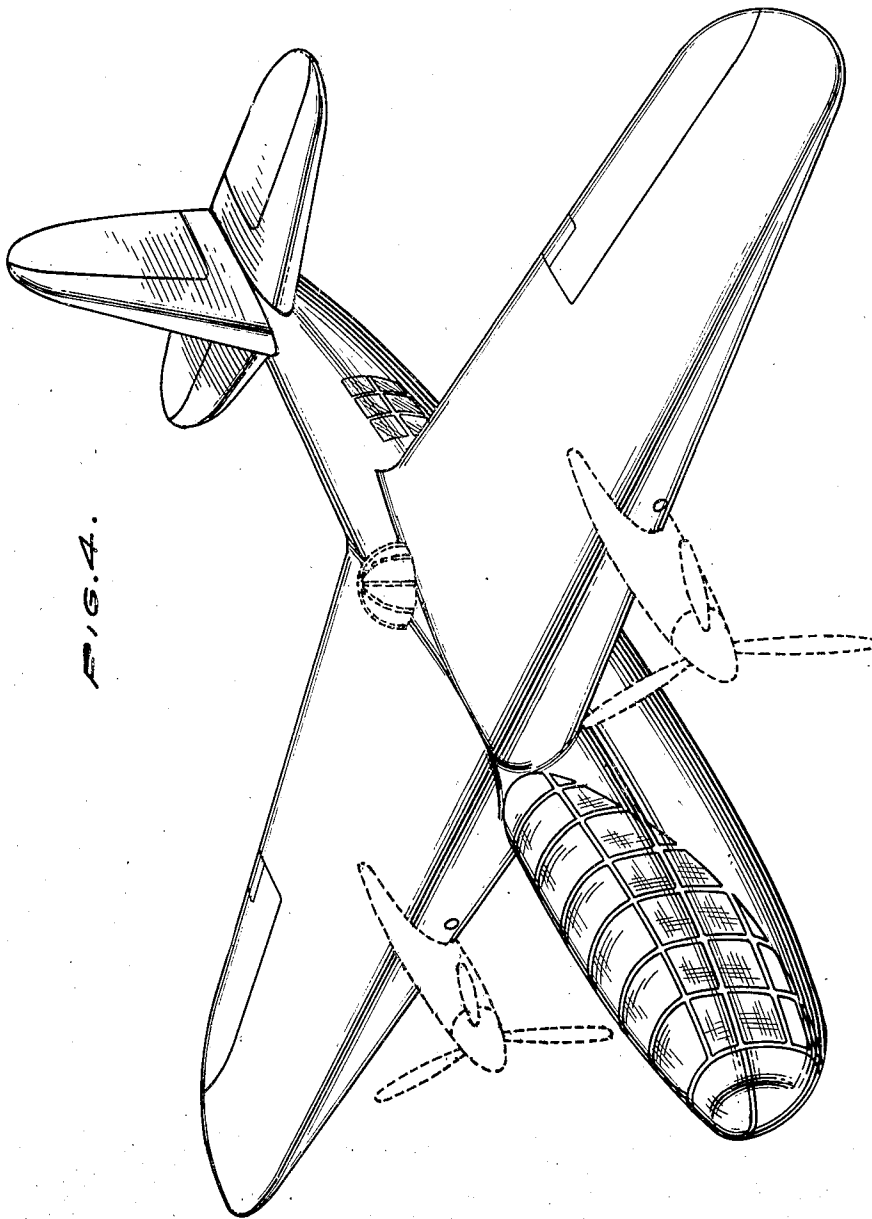

To all whom it may concern:

Be it known that I, Harold W. Case, a citizen of the United States residing at Dayton, in the county of Montgomery and State of Ohio, have invented a new, original, and ornamental Design for an Airplane, of which the following is a specification, reference being had to the accompanying drawings, forming part thereof.
