

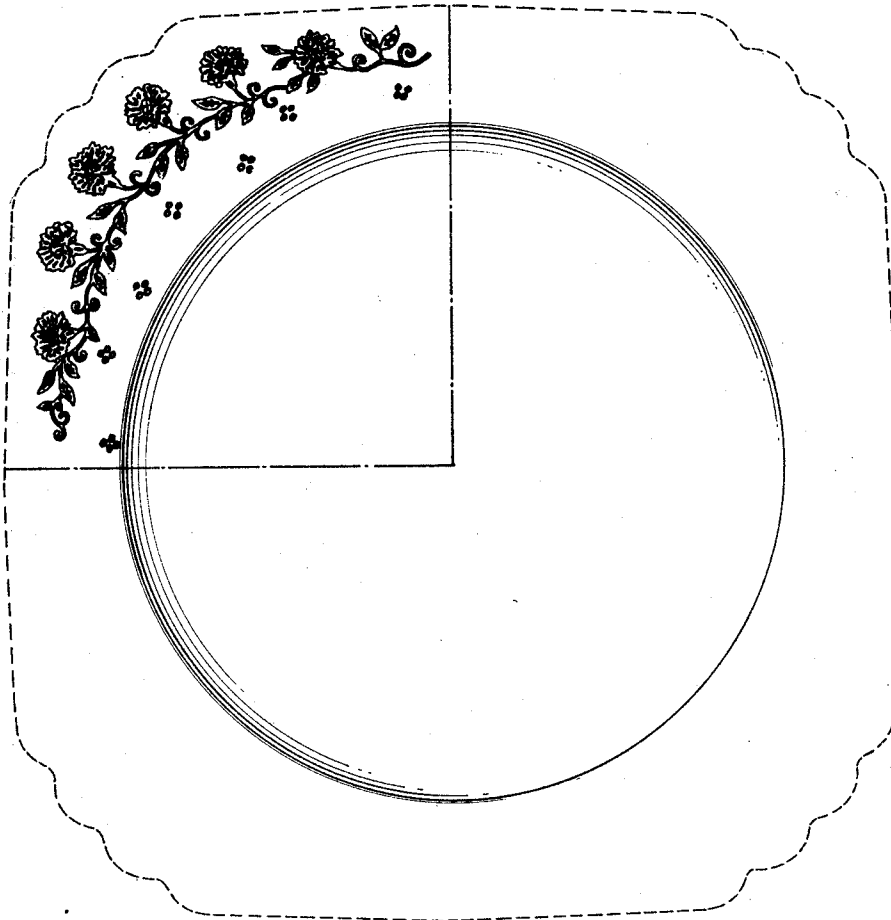

DESIGN FOR A PLATE OR SIMILAR ARTICLE

Application filed November 4, 1930. Serial No. 37,534. Term of patent 7 years.

To all whom it may concern:

Be it known that I, EDGAR M. BOTTOME, a citizen of the United States, residing at Moundsville, in the county of Marshall and State of West Virginia, have invented a new, original, and ornamental Design for a Plate or Similar Article, of which the following is a specification, reference being had to the accompanying drawing, forming part thereof.

In the drawing, the figure is a plan view of a plate or similar article, showing my new design, it being understood that the ornamentation shown in the drawing is repeated around the plate.
