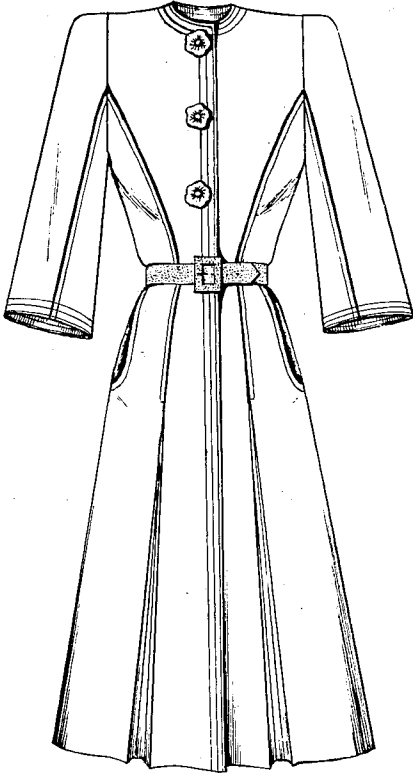

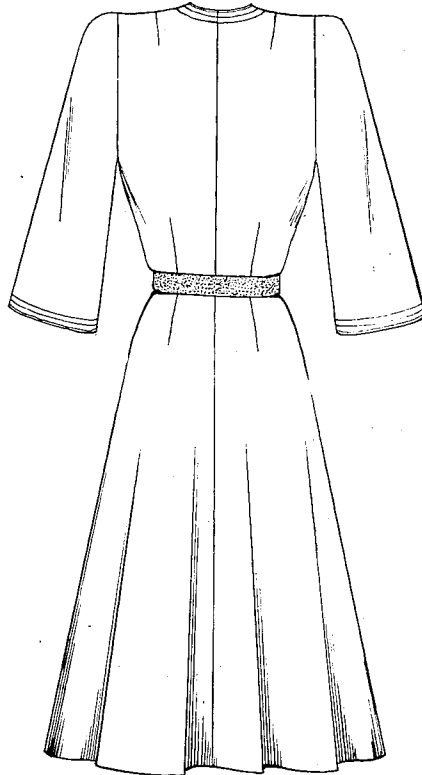

## DESIGN FOR A DRESS
