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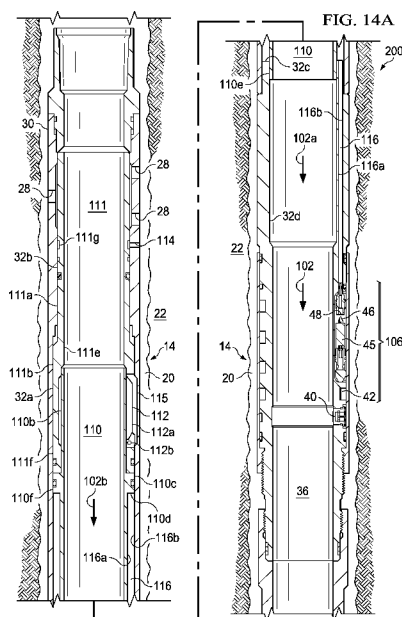

- (57) **Abstract:** A wellbore servicing tool comprising a housing with radial ports (28), a triggering system (106), a first sliding sleeve (110) and a second sliding sleeve (111). First sleeve (110) retains second sleeve (111) in a position where ports (28) are closed. First sleeve (110) is held in a first position by hydraulic fluid retained in chamber (116) by destructible member (48). In operation a signal such as a pressure pulse activates triggering system (106) to actuate piercing member (46) to pierce destructible member (48) which releases hydraulic fluid from chamber (116) whereupon first sleeve (110) moves downward. Hydraulic pressure is applied to shear pins (114) whereupon second sleeve (111) moves downward to open radial ports (28).
