FIG. 5 is a front perspective view showing a second embodiment of our design;

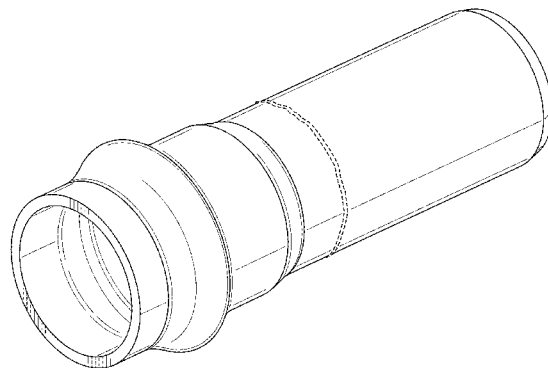
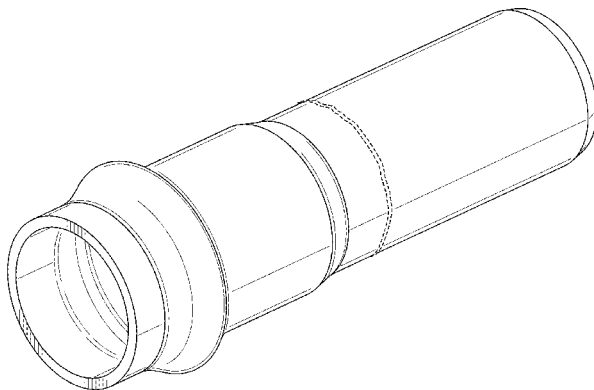
FIG. 6 is a side elevational view thereof;

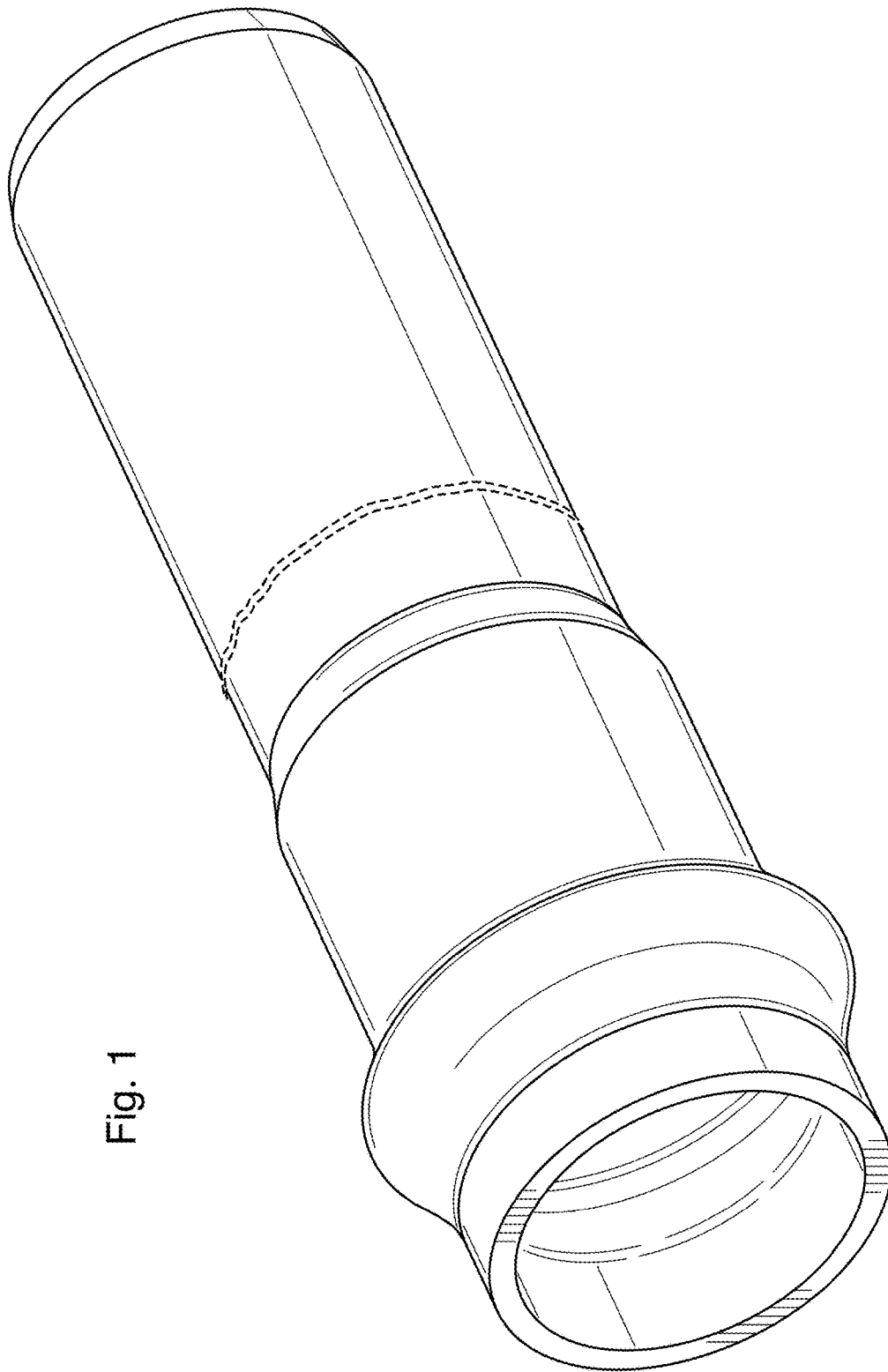

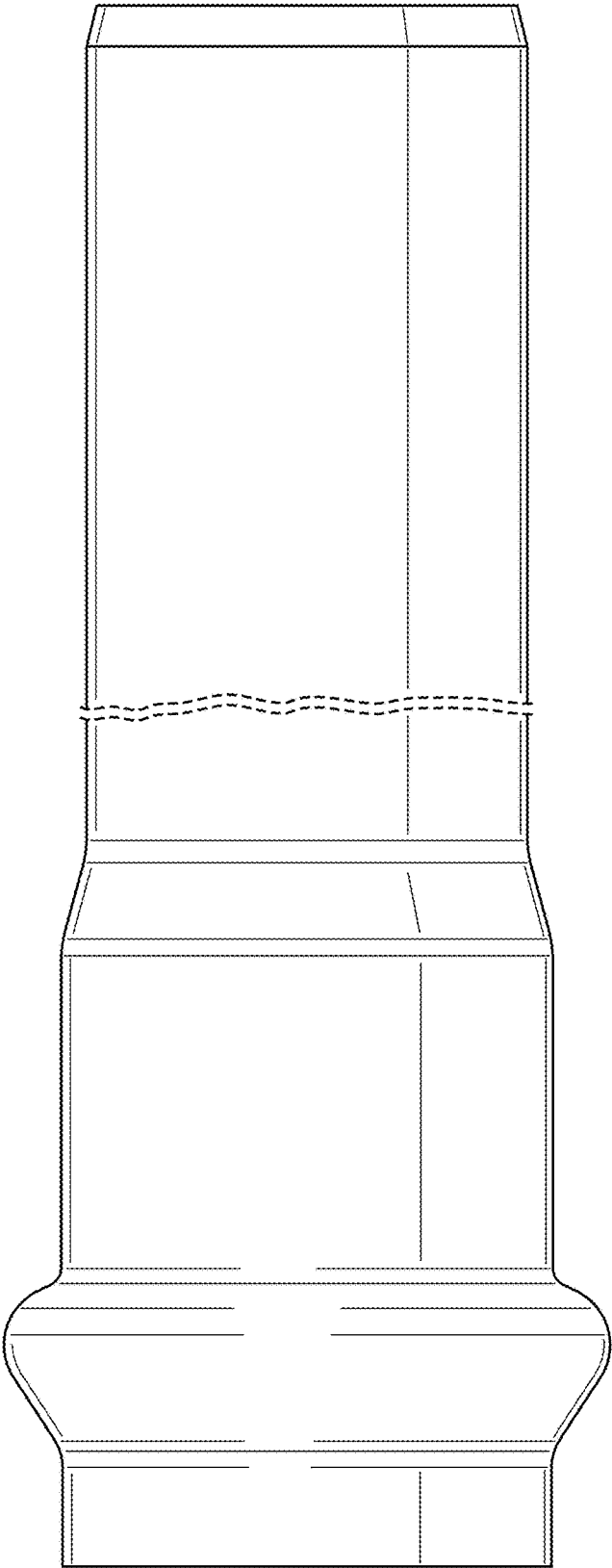

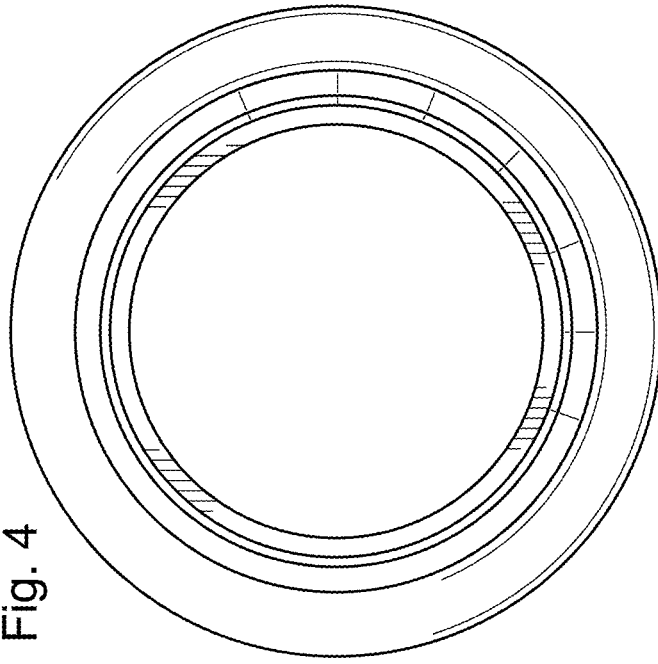
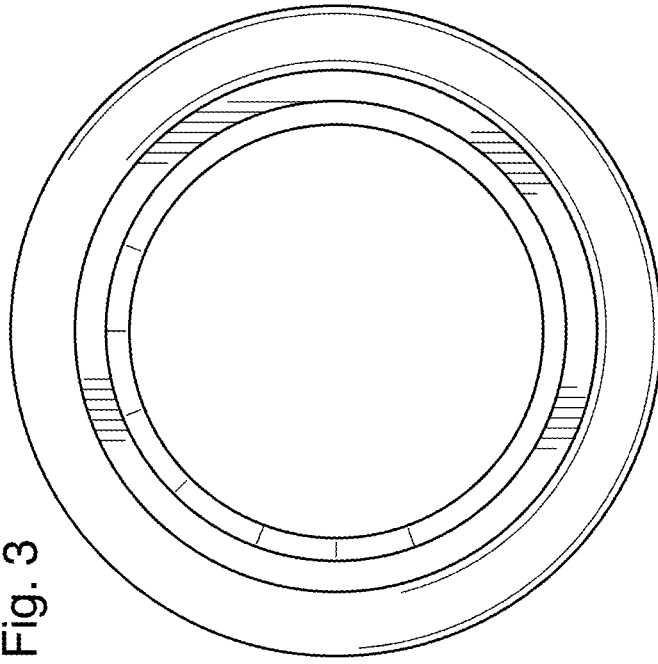

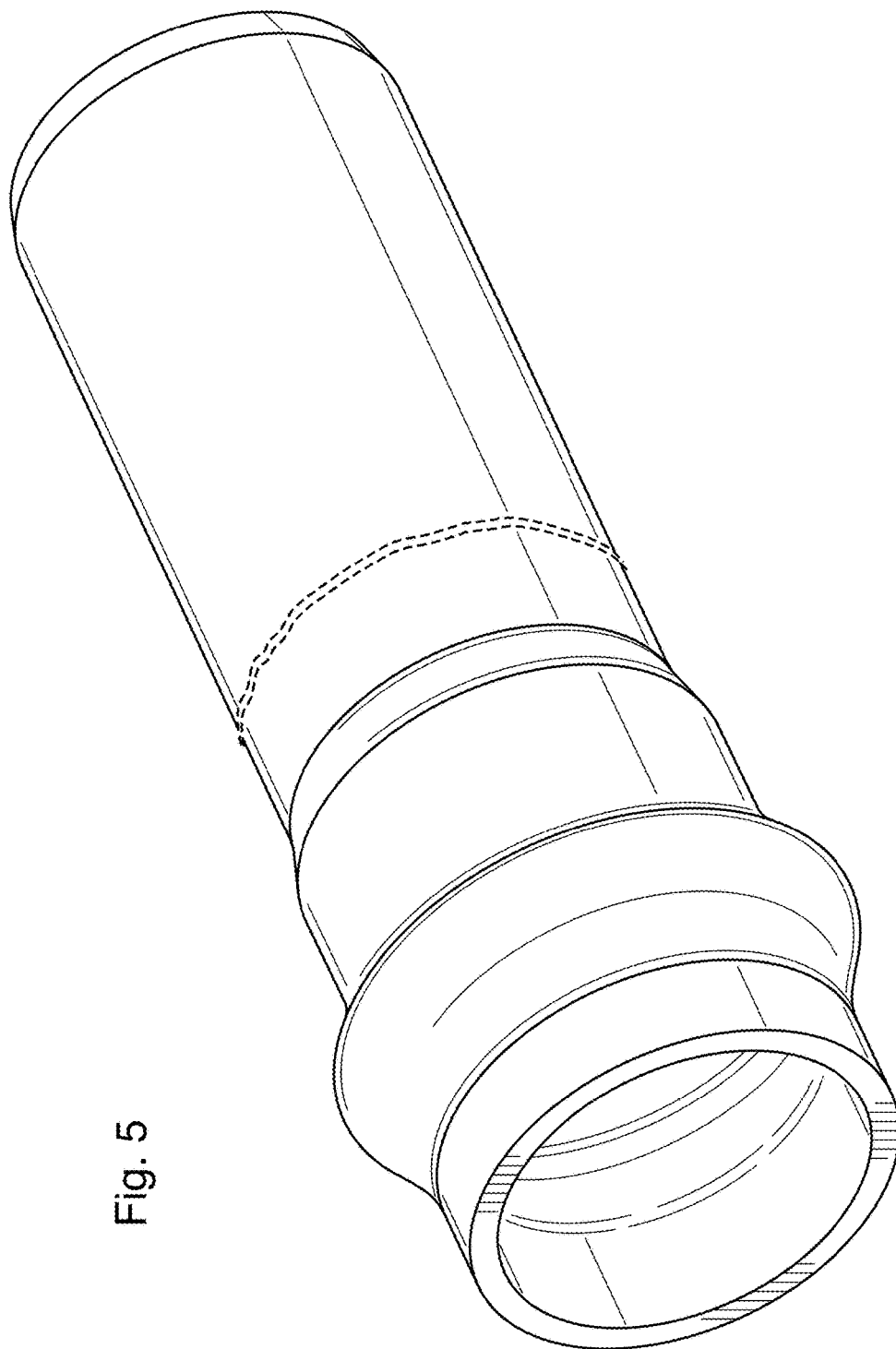

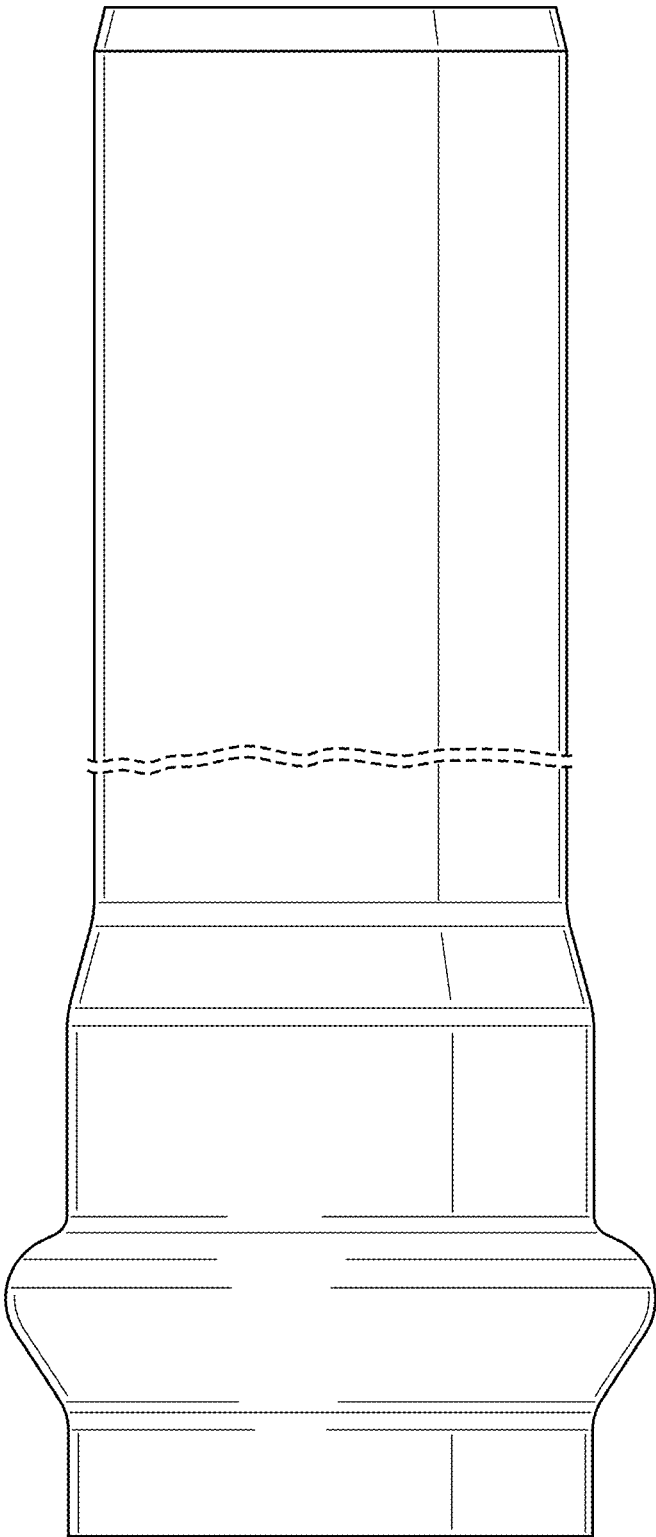

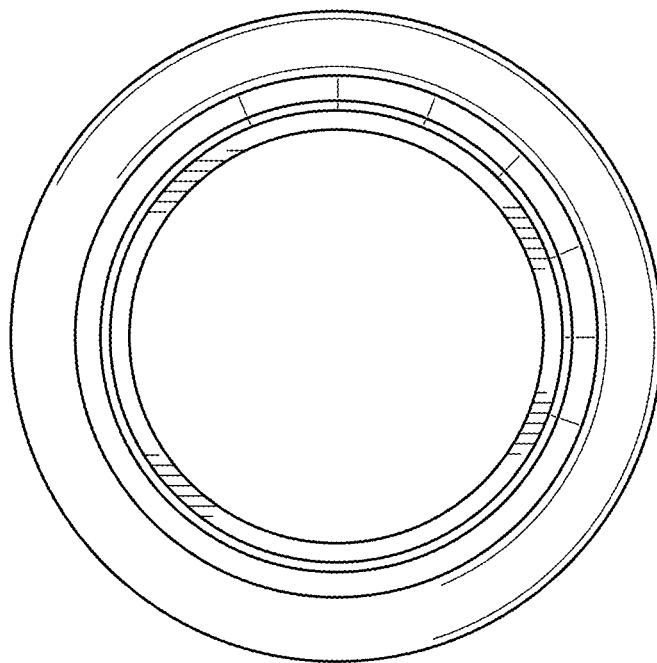
