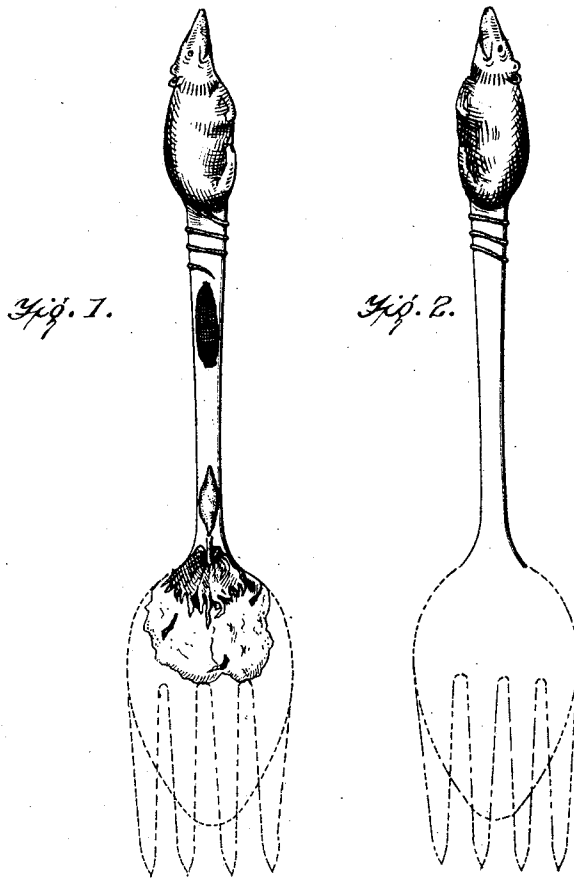

Be it known that I, HARMAN P. ROGERS, a citizen of the United States, residing at Albion, in the county of Noble and State of Indiana, have invented a new, original, and ornamental Design for a Spoon, Fork, or Similar Article, of which the following is a specification, reference being had to the accompanying drawings, forming a part thereof, and in which—
