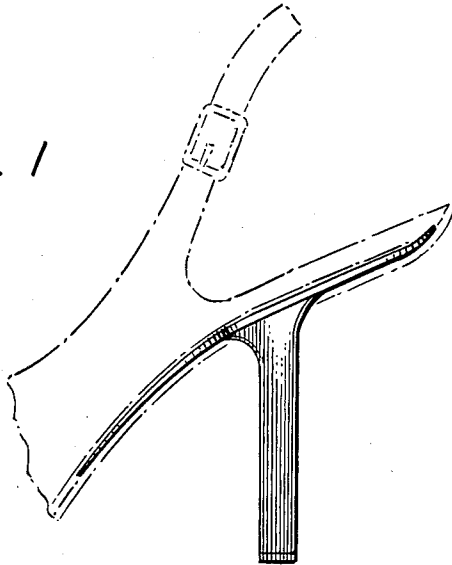

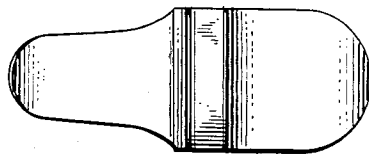
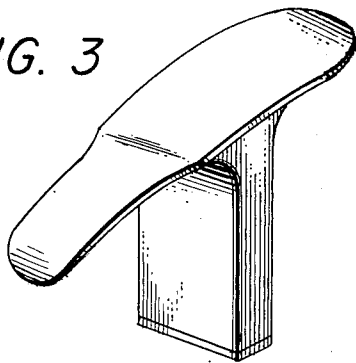

To all whom it may concern:

Be it known that I, Antoine Gazda, a citizen of no country, and a resident of Providence, State of Rhode Island, have invented a new, original, and ornamental Design for a Shoe Heel, of which the following is a specification, reference being had to the accompanying drawing, forming a part thereof.

Fig. 1 is a side elevational view of a shoe heel, showing my new design, the broken lines being for illustrative purposes only.

Fig. 2 is a bottom plan view, and

Fig. 3 is a perspective view.

My design for a shoe heel is characterized by its lengthy narrowness in comparison with the width thereof.

I claim:

The ornamental design for a shoe heel, substantially as shown and described.
