

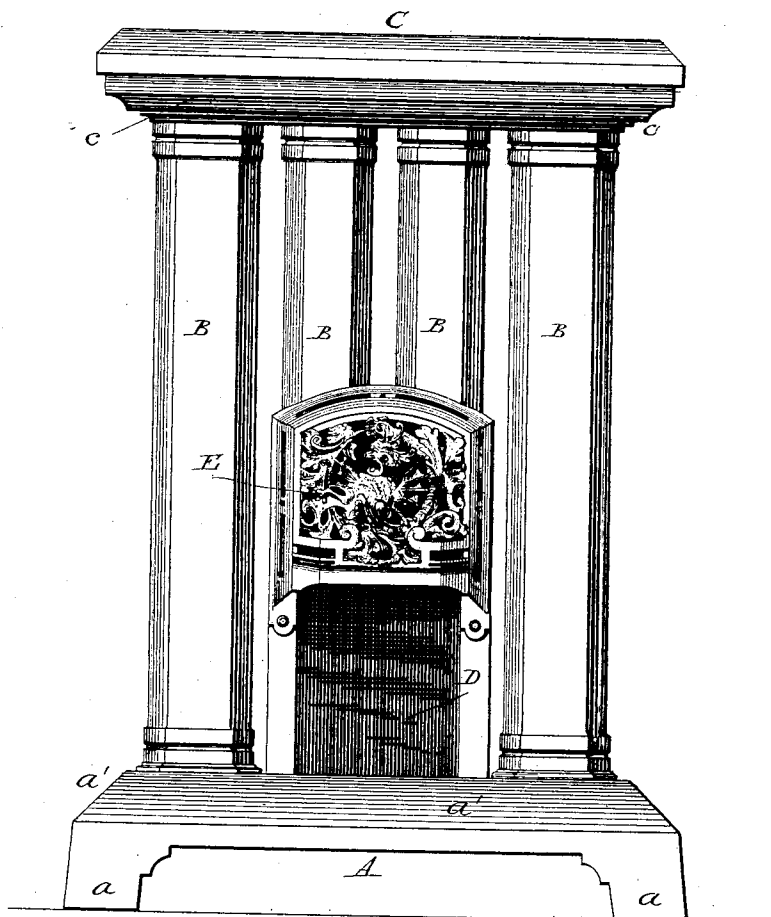

DESIGN FOR A GAS-STOVE.

SPECIFICATION forming part of Design No. 33,927, dated January 15, 1901.

Application filed December 19, 1900. Serial No. 40,452. Term of patent 7 years.

To all whom it may concern:

Be it known that I, EDMOND WALTER TYRRELL RICHMOND, a subject of the Queen of Great Britain, residing at Summercourt, Romford, in the county of Essex, England, have invented and produced a new and original Design for Gas-Stoves, of which the following is a specification.

The accompanying drawing shows a perspective view of a gas-stove embodying my design.

The leading features of my design are the base portion A, having the feet *a* and the sloping top *a'*, the vertical columns B, the cap C, having the molded sides *c*, the cavity D, arranged centrally between the opposite sides

of the columns B and just above the base A, and the ornamented shield E, arranged just above the cavity. The shield E has a molded border with a representation of a dragon in the center surrounded by foliated ornamentations.

I claim—

The design for a gas-stove substantially as herein shown and described.
