

To all whom it may concern:

Be it known that I, Elizabeth C. Holt, a citizen of the United States, residing at 1426 South Burlington Avenue, in the county of Los Angeles and State of California, have invented a new, original, and ornamental Design for a Hand Glare Shield, of which the following is a specification, reference being had to the accompanying drawing, forming part thereof.

Figure 1 is a perspective view showing the hand glare shield in open position embodying my new design;

Figure 2 is a view in front elevation showing the hand glare shield in folded position; and

Figure 3 is a side elevation of the hand glare shield in a folded position embodying my new design.

I claim:

The ornamental design for a hand glare shield, substantially as shown and described.
