DESIGN FOR A FONT OF TYPE.

SPECIFICATION forming part of Design No. 37,235, dated November 15, 1904.

Application filed October 19, 1904. Serial No. 229,200. Term of patent 14 years.

To all whom it may concern:

Be it known that I, MORRIS F. BENTON, a
citizen of the United States, and a resident of
New York, in the county and State of New
York, have invented a new, original, and or-
namental Design for a Font of Type, of which
the following is a specification.

This design is shown in the accompanying
drawings, from which it will be seen that the
font is composed of capital and small letters,

the sign for the word "and," the dollar-mark,
the pound-sterling mark, and a set of Arabic
numerals.

What I claim is—

The ornamental design for a font of type
as herein shown.
