

## DESIGN FOR A COMBINED TOOTHBRUSH AND DENTIFRICE HOLDER

To all whom it may concern:

Be it known that I, Max H. Gass, a citizen of the United States of America, residing at Chelsea, in the county of Suffolk and State of Massachusetts, have invented a new, original, and ornamental Design for a Combined Toothbrush and Dentifrice Holder, of which the following is a specification, reference being had to the accompanying drawing, forming a part thereof.

In the drawing:

Figure 1 is a side elevational view of a combined toothbrush and dentifrice holder embodying my new design;

Figure 2 is a bottom plan view of the same; Figure 3 is a rear elevational view of the same. The drawing has been ruled to represent contrasting color areas. I claim:

The ornamental design for a combined toothbrush and dentifrice holder, as shown and described.
