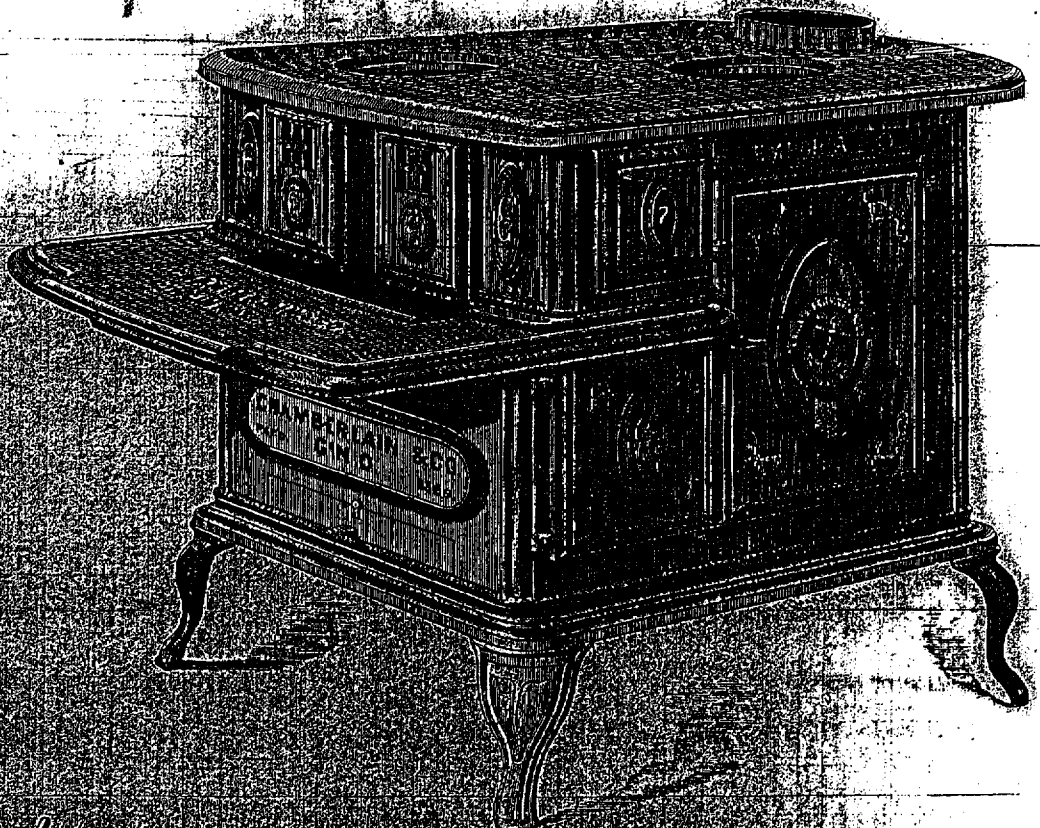

DESIGN FOR A STOVE.

The Schedule referred to in these Letters Patent and making part of the same.

We, ADDIS E. CHAMBERLAIN and JOHN B. CROWLEY, of Cincinnati, Ohio, have invented and produced a new and original Design for Stoves, of which the following is a specification.

The nature of our design is fully represented in the accompanying "wood-cut," to which reference is made.

It is to be here remarked that what is meant by the "ornaments" in the accompanying claims is the figures surrounded by the oval mouldings, together with the figures in the corners of the oven-doors.

Claims.

We claim as our invention, to be used as a design, or part thereof, on a stove—

1. The ornaments shown, when used upon a stove in the manner exhibited.
2. The mouldings shown, when upon a stove in the manner exhibited.
3. The design shown, composed of the ornaments and mouldings, when used upon a stove in the manner exhibited.
