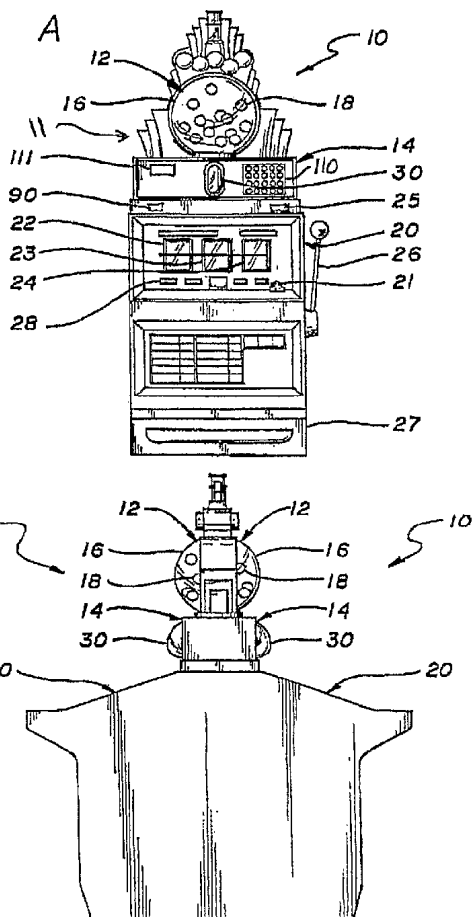

(54) Title: GAMING DEVICE WITH ORGANIC LIGHT EMITTING DIODES AND METHODS OF USE



(57) Abstract: A gaming device has a primary game that includes several reels. An organic light emitting diode display is mounted to at least one of the reels. A bonus game is mounted in association with the primary game. A method is also disclosed for allowing a player to play a primary gaming device. The primary gaming device provides at least one bonus qualifying event. At least one symbol is displayed on an organic light emitting diode display. If the at least one bonus qualifying event occurs, a bonus game is activated. The player is allowed to play the bonus game and any prizes are awarded to the player, hi another embodiment, the organic light emitting diode display is mounted with a bonus game and can be used to display a bonus game outcome.
