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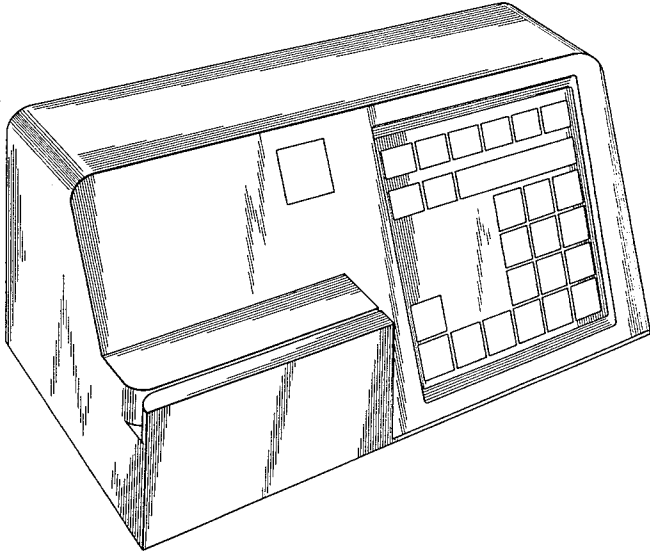

The bottom and right side are substantially plain and unornamented.



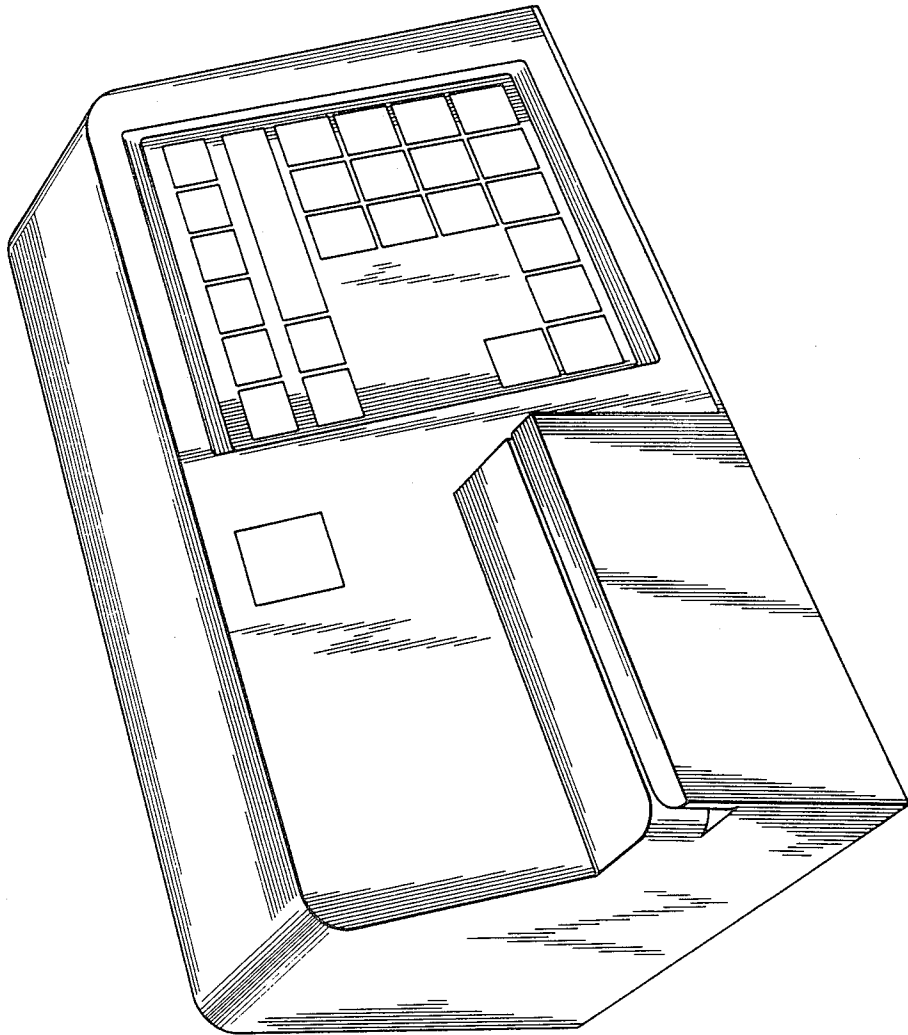
