

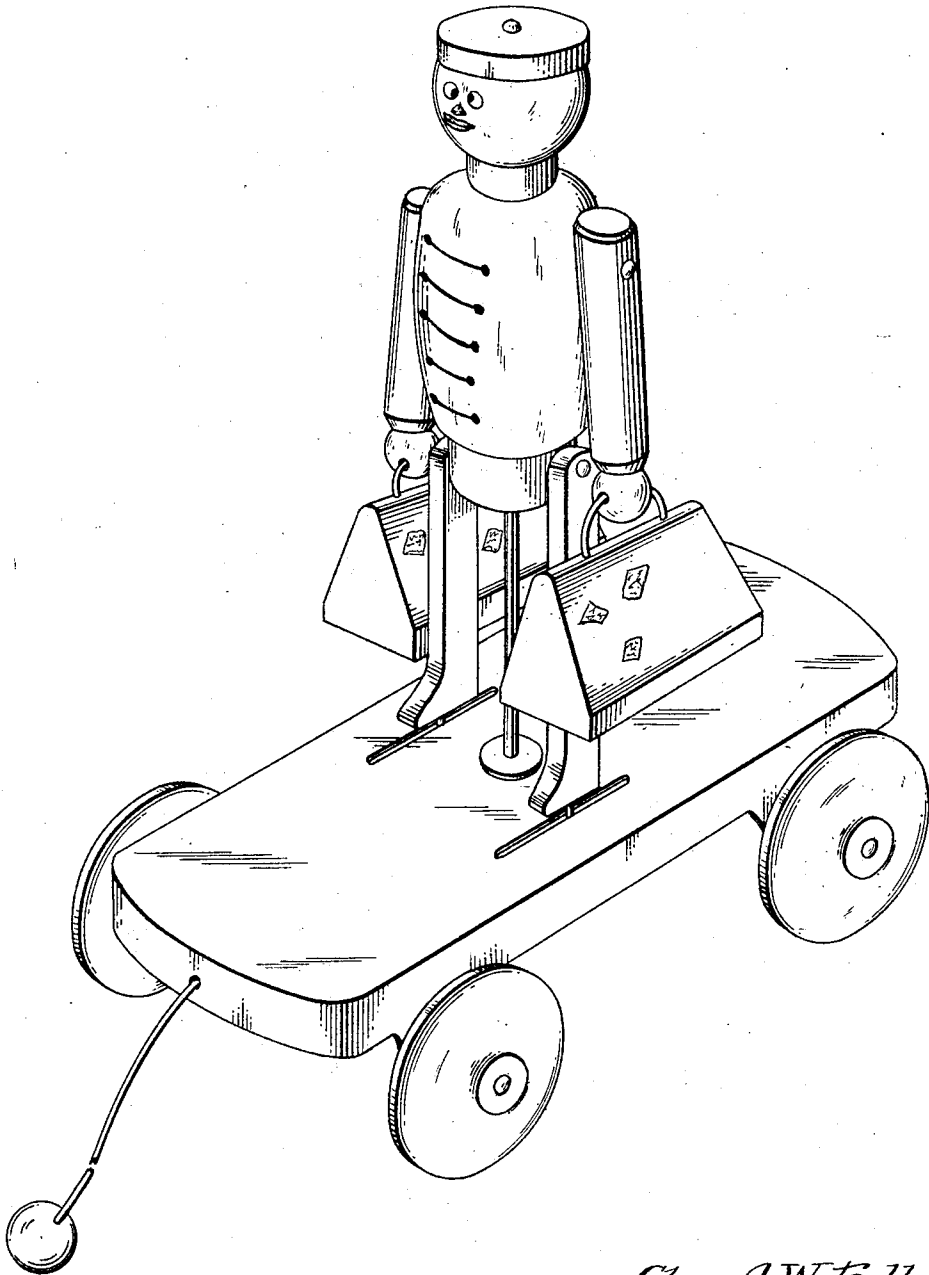

DESIGN FOR A TOY.

Application filed November 12, 1926. Serial No. 19,690. Term of patent $3\frac{1}{2}$ years.
