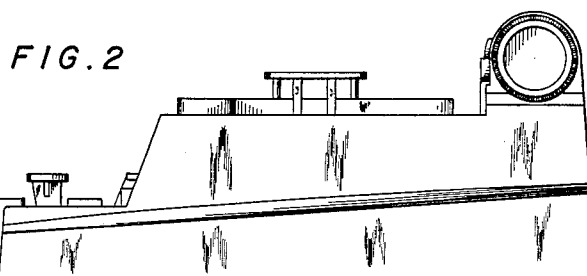
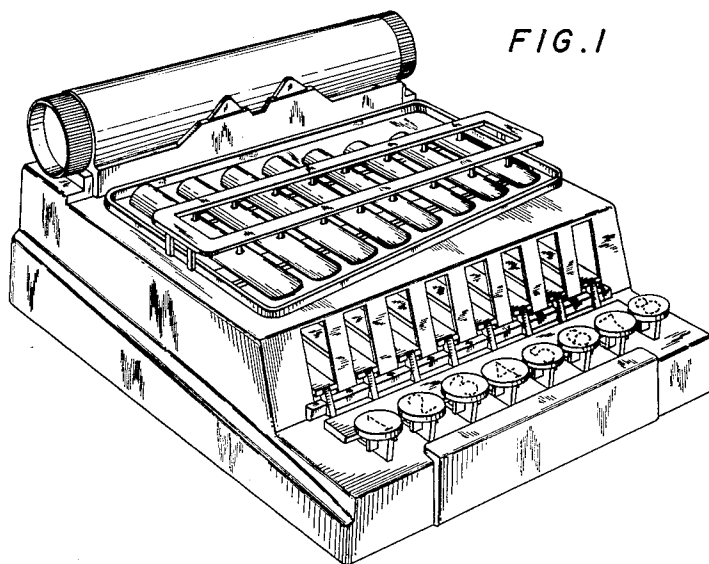

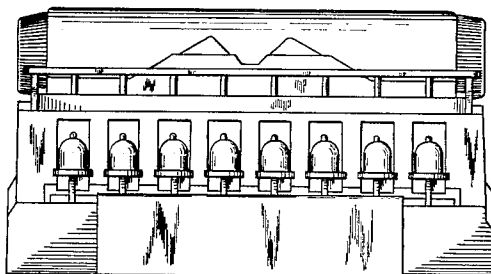

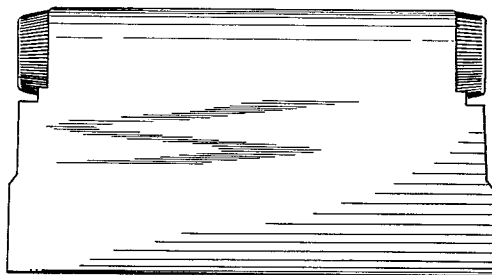


FIG. 1 is a front perspective view of a musical toy typewriter, of my new design;
