

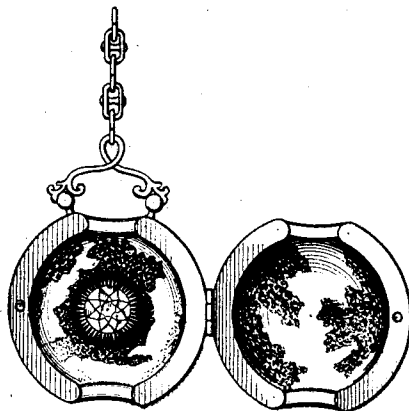

DESIGN FOR A FOB ORNAMENT, LOCKET, OR SIMILAR ARTICLE.

Application filed March 14, 1923. Serial No. 5,474. Term of patent 14 years.

To all whom it may concern:

Be it known that I, MARSHALL B. GARDNER, a citizen of the United States, residing at Aurora, in the county of Kane and State of Illinois, have invented a new, original, and ornamental Design for Fob Ornament, Locket, or Similar Article, of which the following is a specification, reference being had to the accompanying drawings, and which form a part of this specification.

The drawing is a representation of the interior of a fob ornament, locket or similar article, embodying my design.
