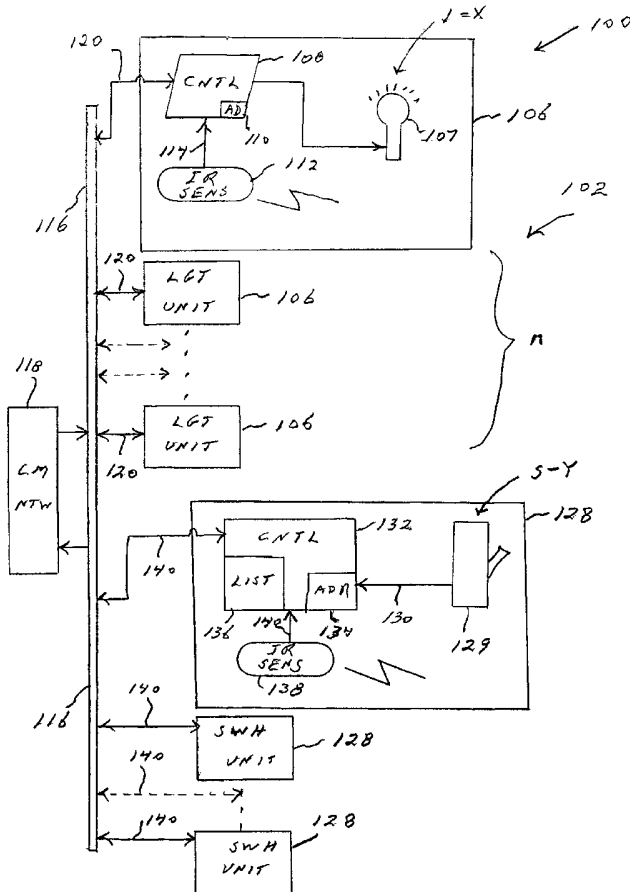

(54) Title: GENERAL OPERATING SYSTEM



(57) Abstract: A correlation system is provided which is adapted for use with a lighting system (102) associated with one or more wands (104). The lighting system (102) includes lighting units (106) having lights (107). The lights (107) are controlled by a controller (108). Switch units (128) are provided. Through signals transmitted from the wands (104), control relationships can be established between the switch units (128) and the lighting units (106).
