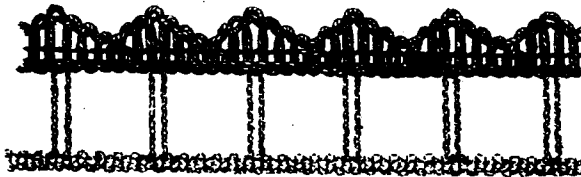

To all whom it may concern:

Be it known that I, DAVID JARVIS, Jr., a citizen of the United States, residing in Philadelphia, Pennsylvania, have invented a new, original, and ornamental Design for Lace Edging, of which the following is a specification.

My invention relates to the ornamental border of such edging and in the accompanying drawing I have shown a view of such border, associated with the balance of a fabric structure with which it is usually employed, shown by dotted lines. The fabric structure shown by dotted lines is that having openings through which ribbon may

be inserted when the edging as a whole is employed for garments of various kinds. It will be understood, of course, that the border or edging proper, constituting my improved design, may be used in connection with any form of heading or other fabric structure, or it may be used independently.

I claim:

The ornamental design for a lace edging substantially as shown and described.
