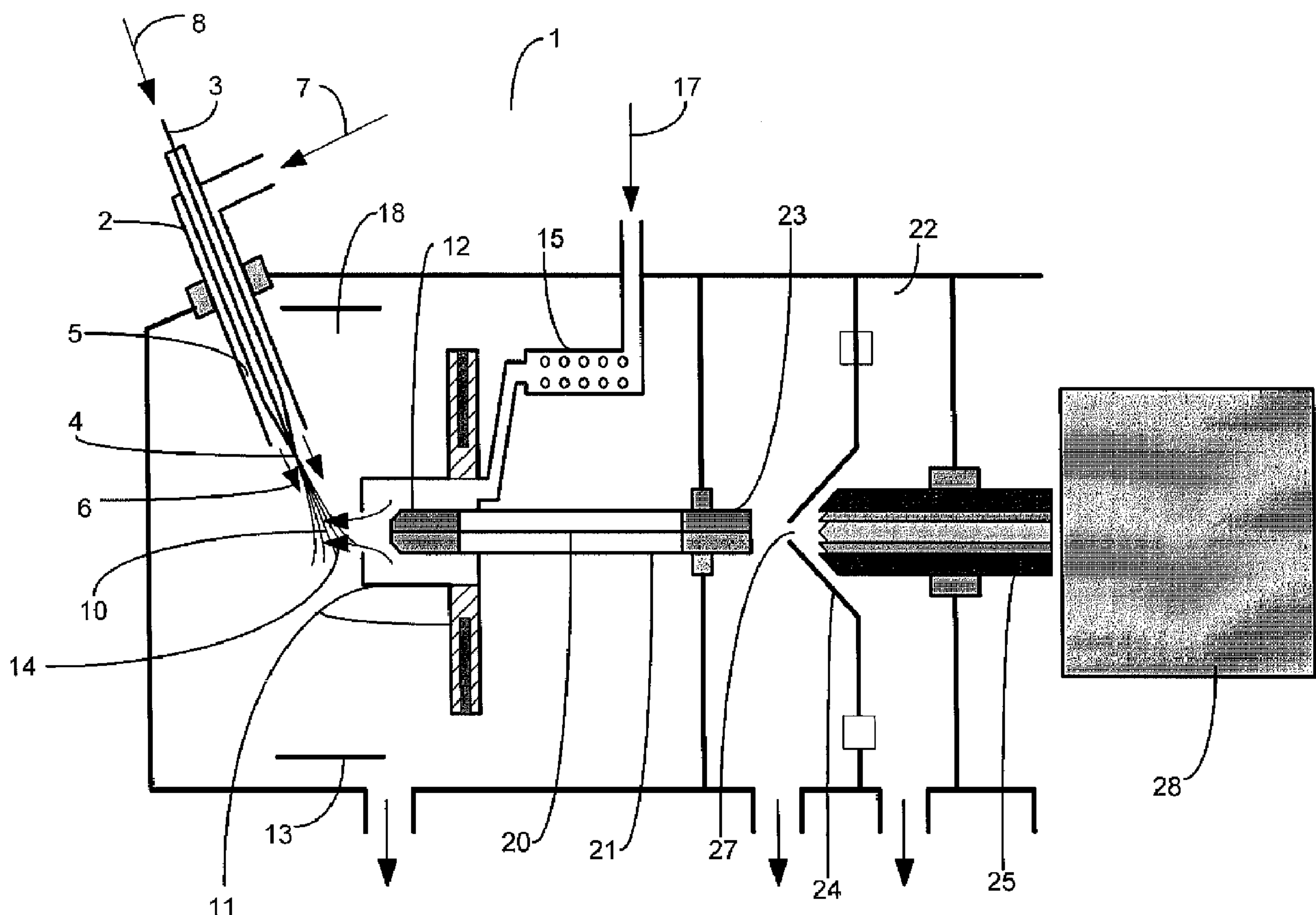




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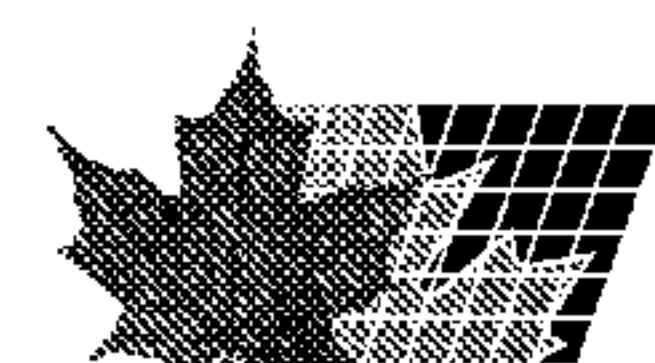

A new set of Electrolytes has been found that Increases positive and negative polarity analyte ion signal measured in ESMS analysis when compared with analyte ESMS signal achieved using more conventional electrolytes. The new electrolyte species increase ES MS signal when added directly to a sample solution or when added to a second solution flow In an Electrospray membrane probe. The new electrolytes can also be added to a reagent ion source configured in a combination Atmospheric pressure ion source to improve ionization efficiency,
