




FIG. 1 is a perspective view of a single panel of the panel unit shown in FIG. 2,

FIG. 2 is a perspective view of a panel unit showing our new design, the broken lines showing of the door frame being disclosed for illustrative purposes only.

FIG. 3 is a sectional view taken on line 3—3 of FIG. 2. FIG. 4 is a sectional view taken on line 4—4 of FIG. 3. FIG. 5 is a view taken along line 5—5 of FIG. 1.

The characteristic features of the design reside in the surface ornamentation. The rear of the unit is plain.
