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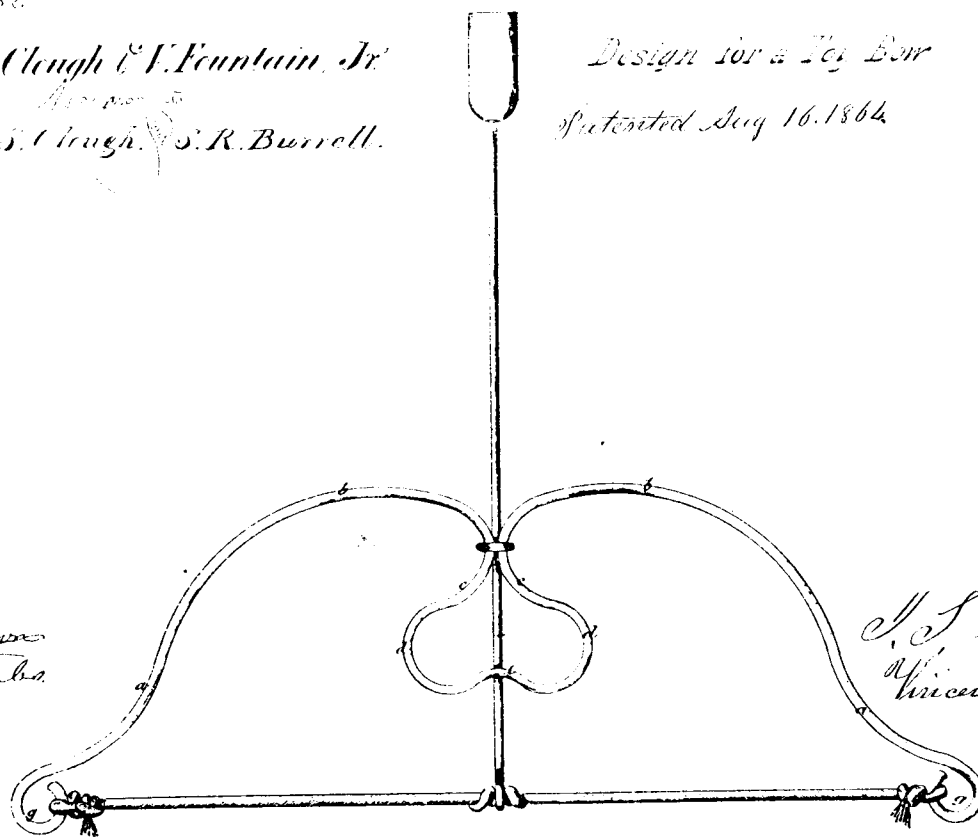

Design for a Toy Bow.

The schedule referred to in these Letters Patent and making part of the same.

To all whom it may concern:

Be it known that we, Isaac S. Clough, of the City of Brooklyn, in the County of Kings, and State of New York, and Vincent Fountain Jr. of Castleton, in the County of Richmond, and State of New York, have invented a new design for a Toy Bow; and we do hereby declare that the following is a full, clear and exact description of the same, reference being had to the accompanying drawing forming part of this specification, said drawing representing a side view of the bow.

The design of this bow consists in its peculiar longitudinal curvature which is of a form representing two ovals, *a b*, each forming half of the middle of the bow, which curve inward from those first mentioned, and a curve *c* uniting with the curves *d d* of the smaller ovals.

At the ends of the bow where the elastic string is attached there are two formed eyes.

What we claim as our invention, and desire to secure by Letters Patent, is—
