pump embodying our new design;

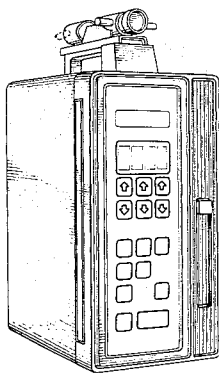
FIG. 2 is a top view of the pump shown in FIG. 1;

part of the claim.



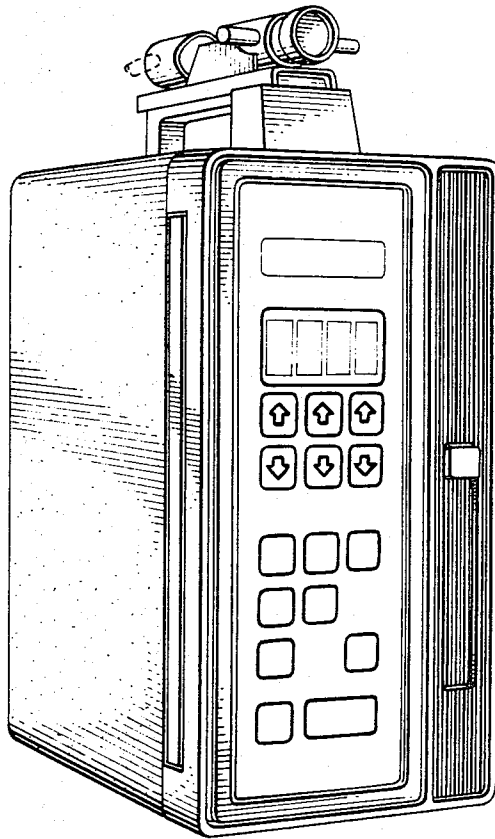

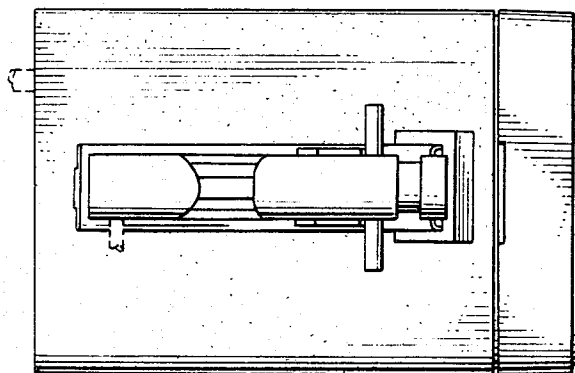

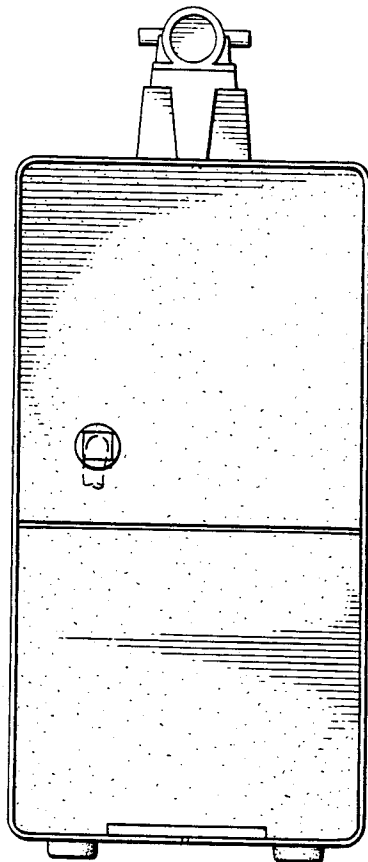

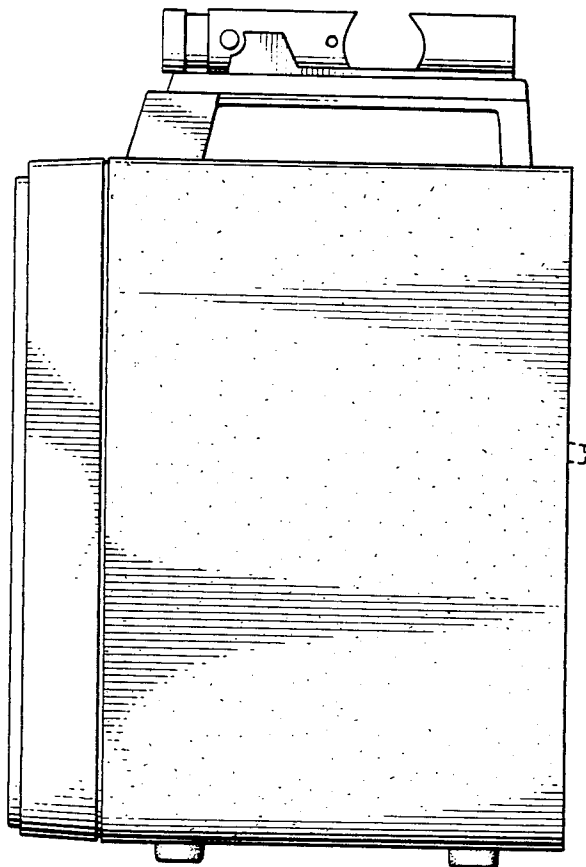
