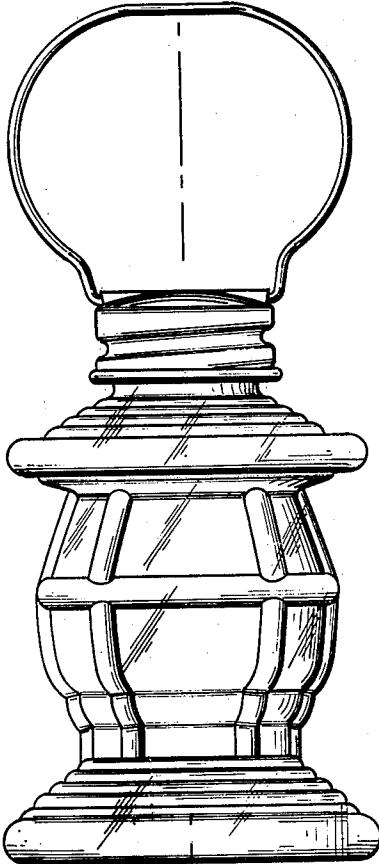

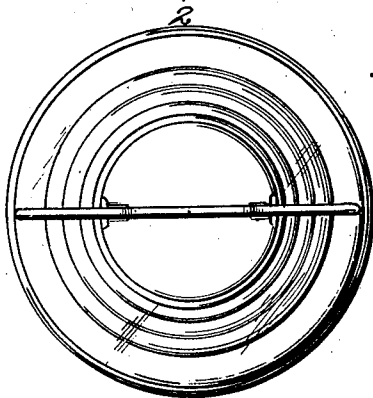
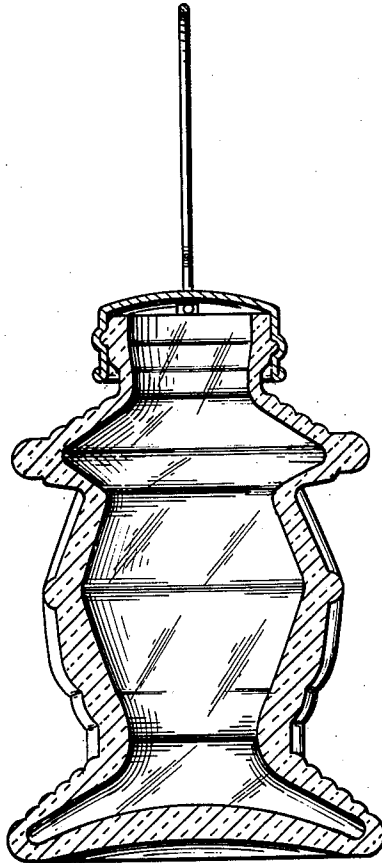

To all whom it may concern:

Be it known that I, Turney H. Stough, a citizen of the United States, residing at Jeannette, in the county of Westmoreland and State of Pennsylvania, have invented a new, original, and ornamental Design for a Toy Candy Container, of which the following is a specification, reference being had to the accompanying drawing, forming part thereof.

In the drawing:

Figure 1 is a side elevational view of a toy candy container, showing my new design,
