To all whom it may concern:

Be it known that I, Glenn W. Tammen, a citizen of the United States, residing at Chicago, in the county of Cook and State of Illinois, have invented a new, original, and ornamental Design for a Thermoplastic Tube or Similar Article, of which the following is a specification, reference being had to the accompanying drawing, forming a part thereof.

In the drawing:

The figure is a side elevation of a thermoplastic tube showing my new design.

The essential feature of my design resides in the surface ornamentation of the tube. The thickness of the tube is conventional.

I claim:

The ornamental design for a thermoplastic tube or similar article, as shown and described.
