

CLAIM

[57] The ornamental design for a utility hook for apertured boards, substantially as shown.

DESCRIPTION

FIG. 1 is a perspective view of the utility hook for apertured boards showing our new design; FIG. 2 is a top plan view; FIG. 3 is a rear elevational view; FIG. 4 is a side elevational view taken from the left of FIG. 1; FIG. 5 is a front elevational view; FIG. 6 is a bottom plan view.














