

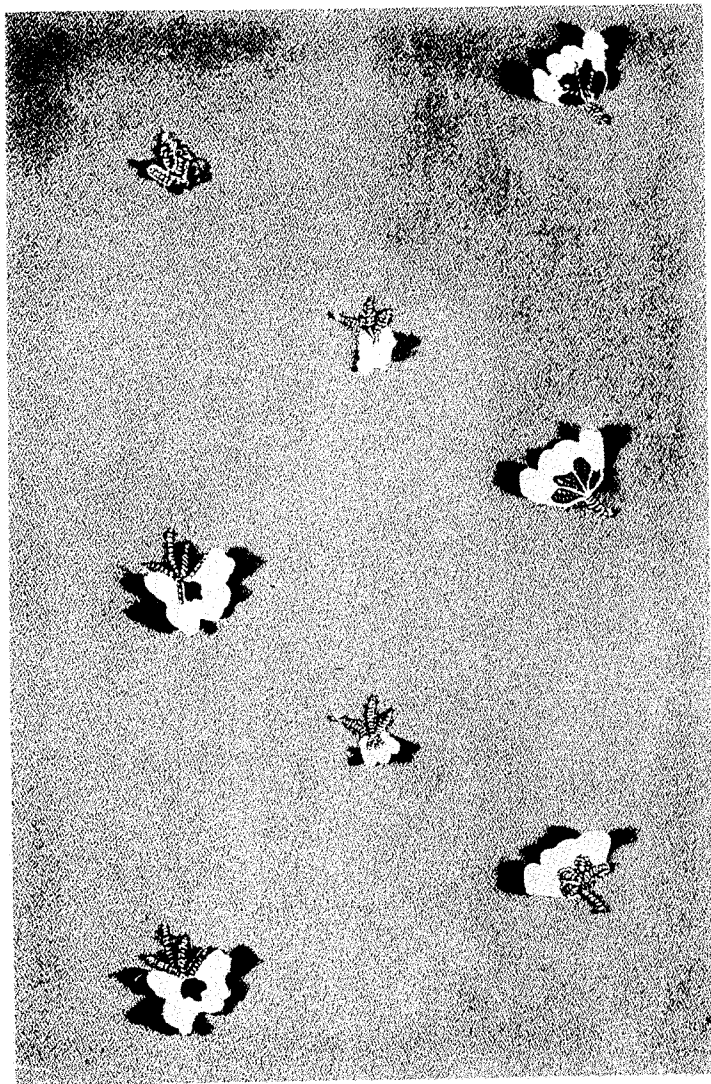

DESIGN FOR A FLOWER-EMBROIDERED DRESS FABRIC

To all whom it may concern:

Be it known that I, Rica Stiglitz, a citizen of the United States, residing at New York, in the county of New York and State of New York, have invented a new, original, and ornamental Design for a Flower-Embroidered Dress Fabric, of which the following is a specification, reference being had to the drawing, wherein the figure is a plan view of a unit of flower-embroidered dress fabric showing my new design,

The characteristic feature of the design resides in the arrangement of the embroidered floral elements on the fabric background as shown, the embroidered flower petals being superposed upon the fabric and attached thereto by stems embroidered upon the fabric.

I claim:

The ornamental design for a flower-embroidered dress fabric, as shown and described.
