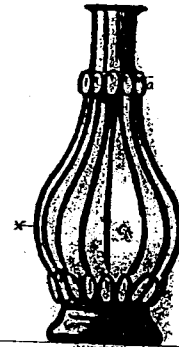

The schedule referred to in these Letters Patent, & making part of the same.  
To all whom it may concern,

Be it known that I, Augustus E. Wetherill, of Cincinnati, Hamilton County, Ohio, have invented or produced a new ornamental design for a perfumery bottle, of which the following is descriptive, reference being had to the annexed drawings, making part of this specification, & in which,

Fig 1, is a front elevation

Fig 2, is a rear elevation

Fig 3, is a horizontal section

through the line x, x. -

The base of the neck at its junction with the body, is girdled by a wreath or whorl of petals or leaves (a), below which the body (b) of the bottle, has the represented lyre form. The body is longitudinally fluted (c), as represented, a flat panel (d) being provided on the front side for the label.

The junction of the body with the foot has a wreath (e), similar to the upper one.

The foot (f) has the represented cyma-reversa form.

All of the bottle below the neck has an oval horizontal section

I claim as new & of my invention. - The ornamental design of bottle, substantially as represented. -
