

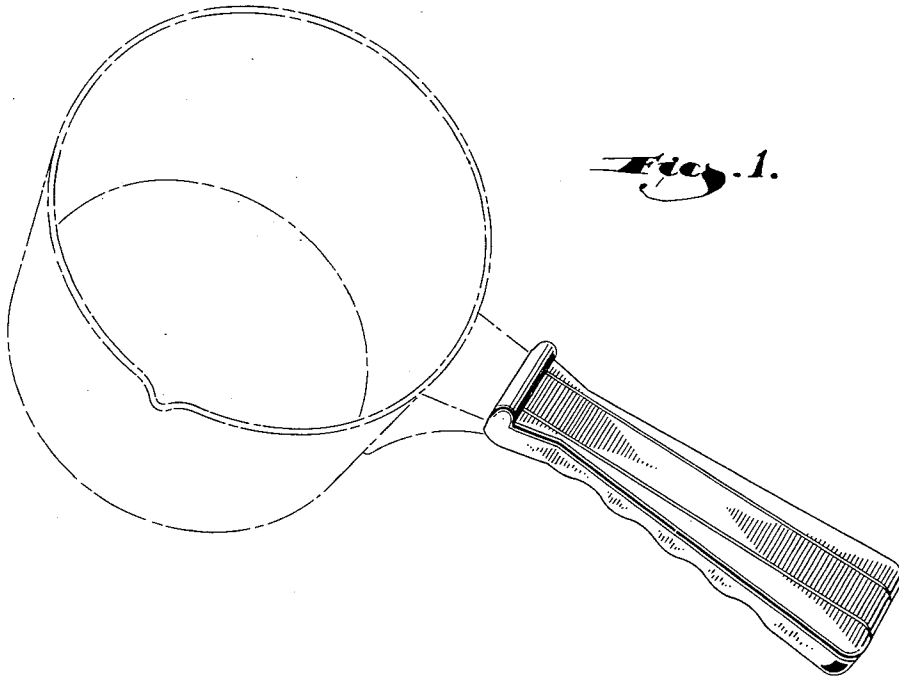

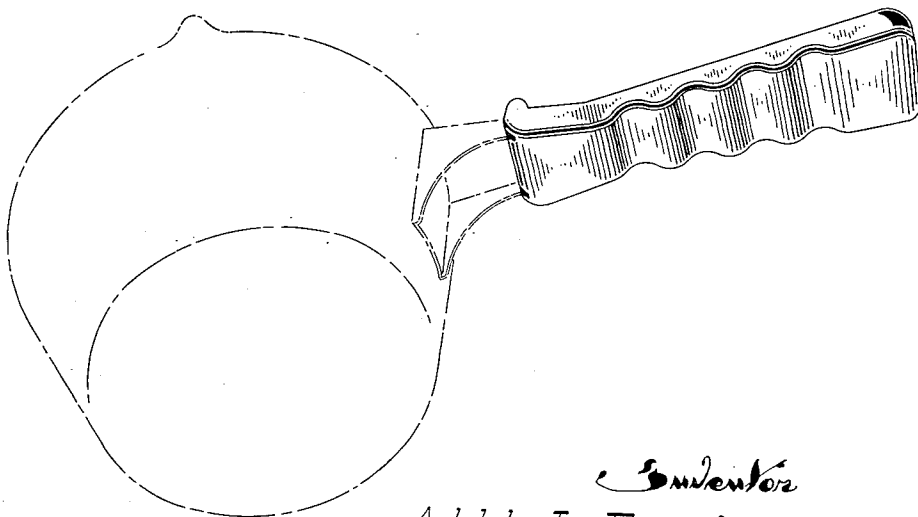

*To all whom it may concern:*

Be it known that I, Adolph L. Rosenheimer, Jr., a citizen of the United States, residing at Kewaskum, in the county of Washington and State of Wisconsin, have invented a new, original, and ornamental Design for a Cooking Pan or Similar Article, of which the following is a specification, reference being had to the accompanying drawing, forming part thereof.

Figure 1 is a perspective view looking toward

the upper portion of the cooking pan or similar article, showing my design; and

Figure 2 is a perspective view looking toward the under portion thereof.

The dominant feature of the design resides in the portion shown in full lines.
