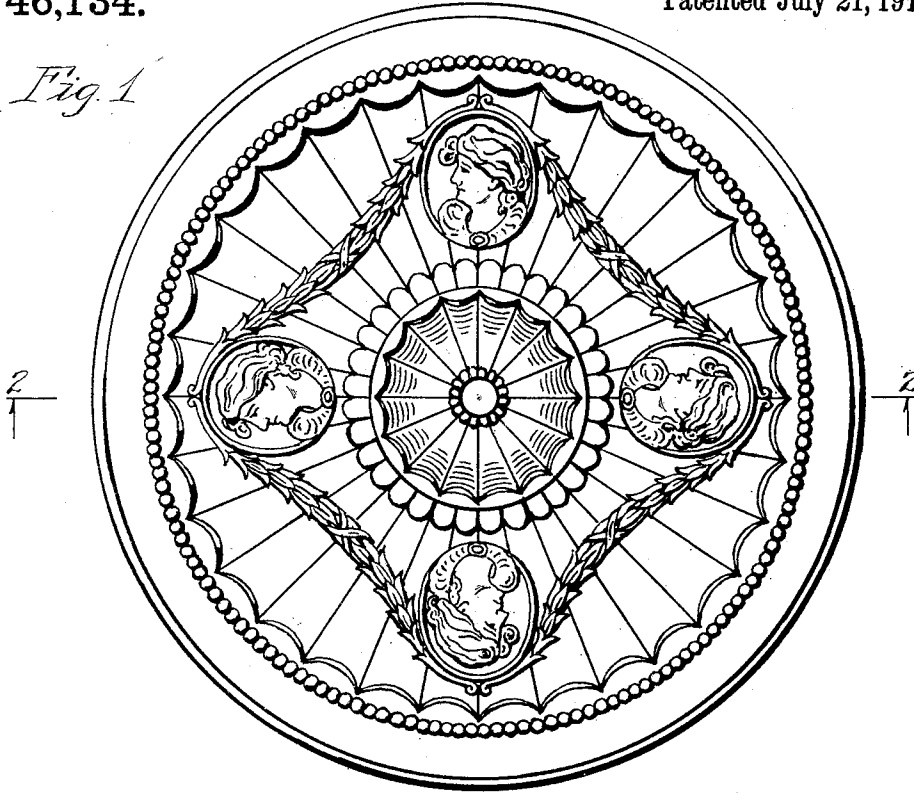
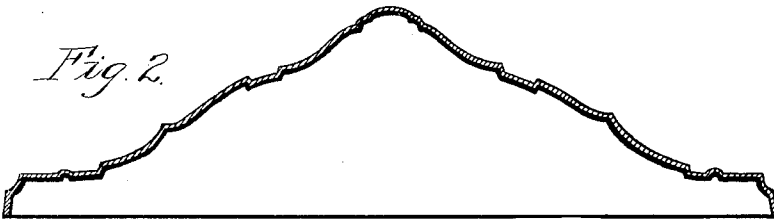

To all whom it may concern:

Be it known that I, PAUL MOHRMANN, a citizen of the United States, residing at Chicago, in the county of Cook and State of Illinois, have invented a new, original, and ornamental Design for Plates for Lighting-Fixtures, of which the following is a specification, reference being had to the accompanying drawings, forming a part thereof.

In the drawings:—Figure 1 is a bottom plan view of a plate embodying this design. Fig. 2 is a section taken as indicated at line 2—2 on Fig. 1.
