[57] CLAIM


The ornamental design for a combined handle and shank for surgical instrument, as shown and described.

DESCRIPTION

FIG. 1 is an elevational view showing the left side of a combined handle and shank for surgical instrument embodying my new design;

FIG. 2 is an elevational view showing the right side of the combined handle and shank for surgical instrument; FIG. 3 is a sectional view taken along line 3—3 of FIG. 1 showing the front side of the combined handle and shank for surgical instrument;
