DESCRIPTION

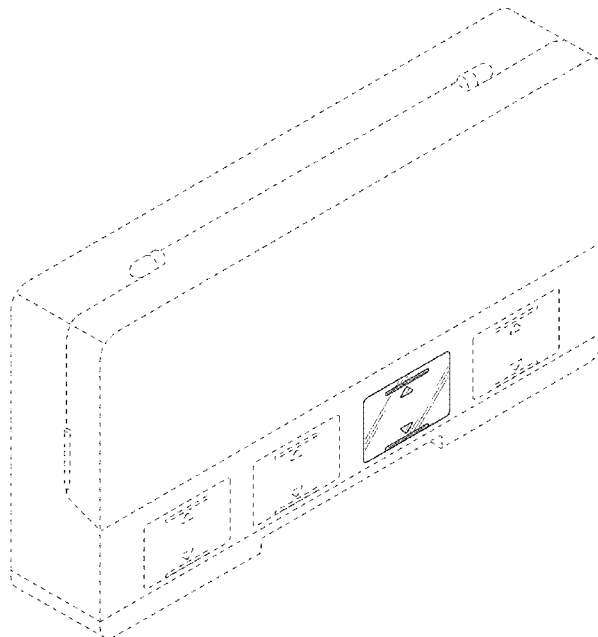

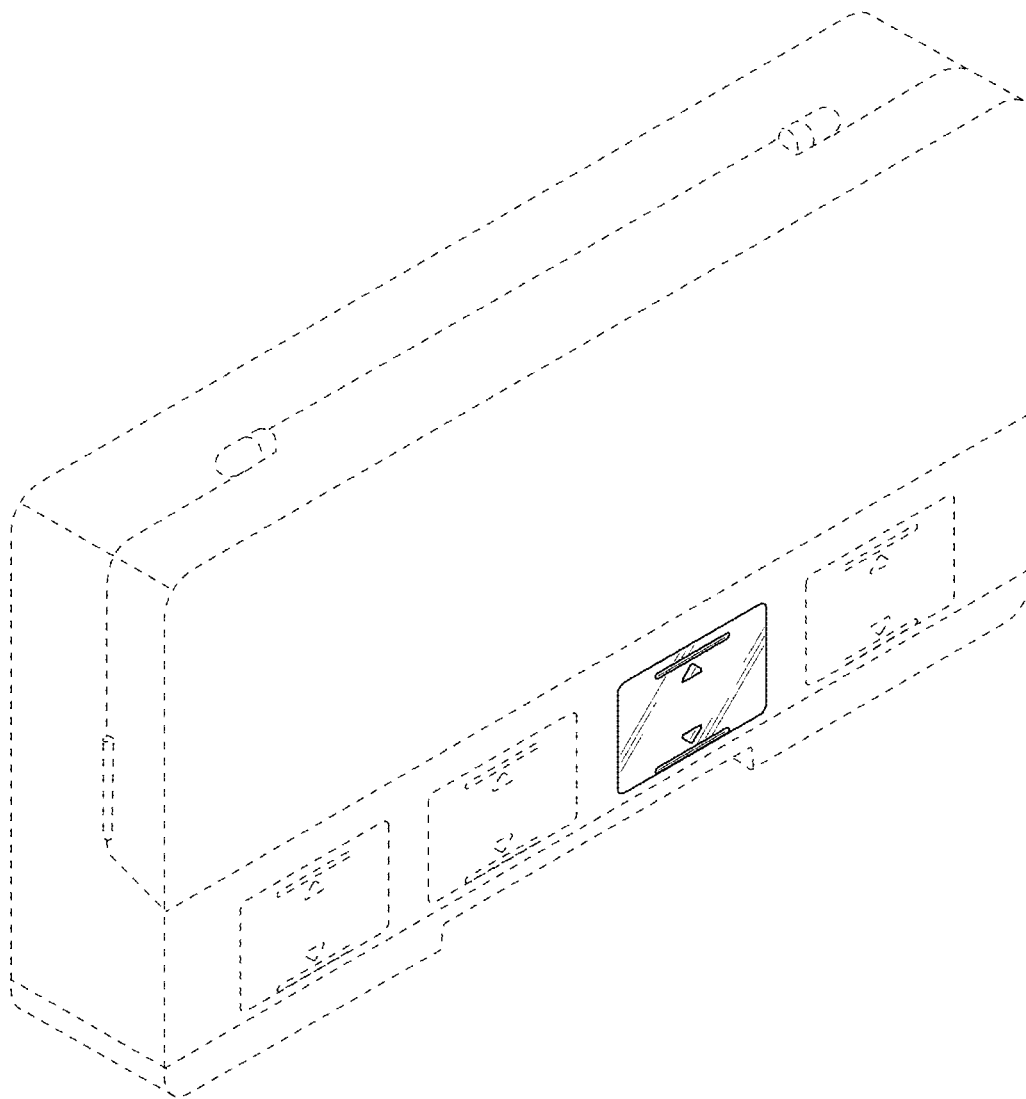

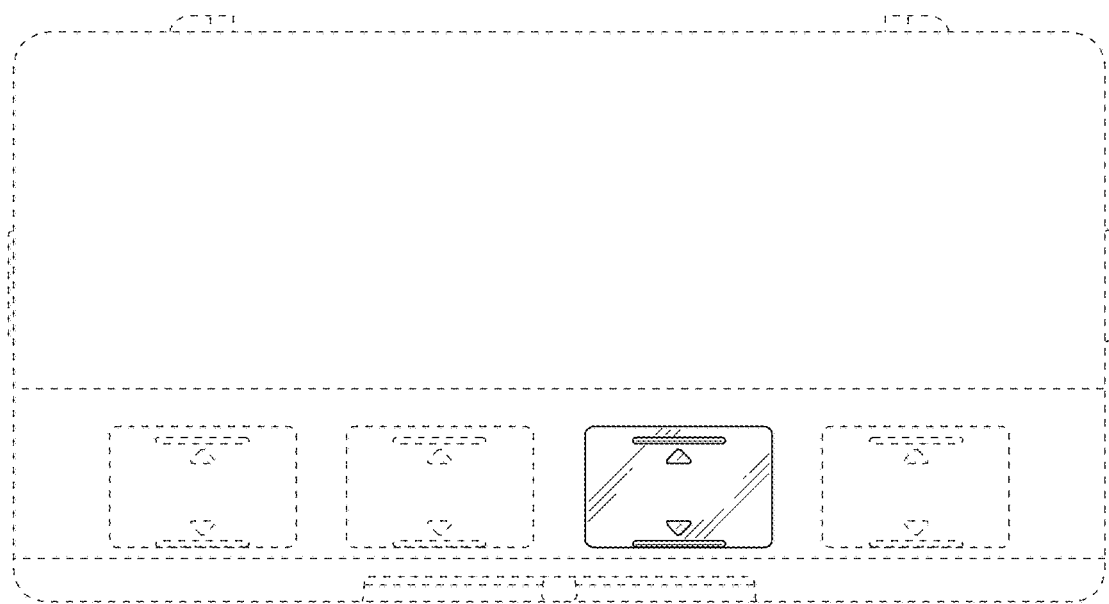

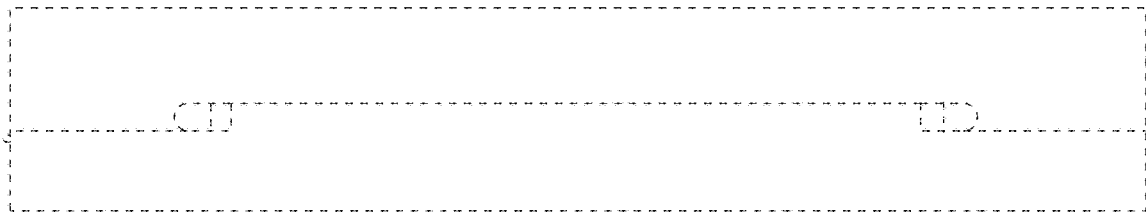

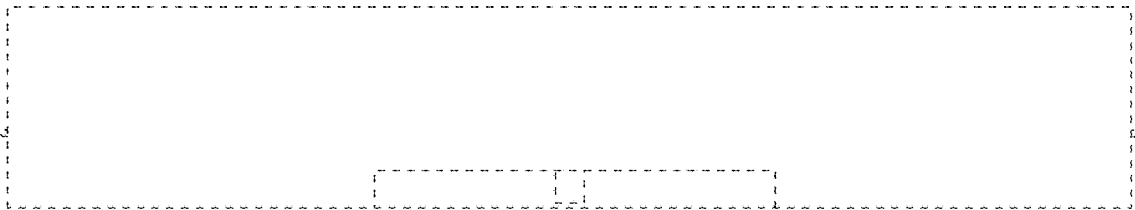

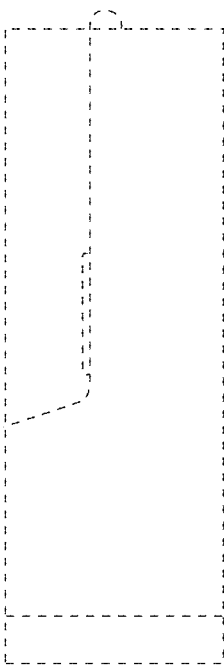
