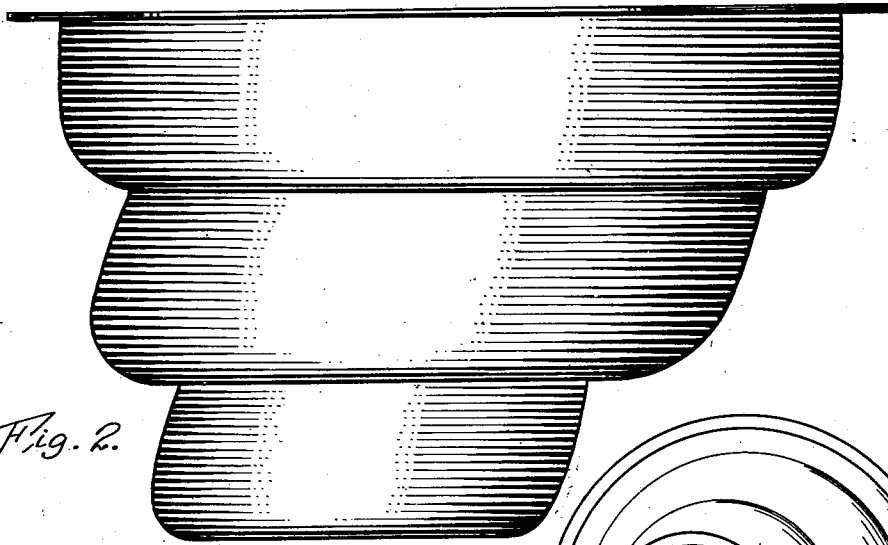

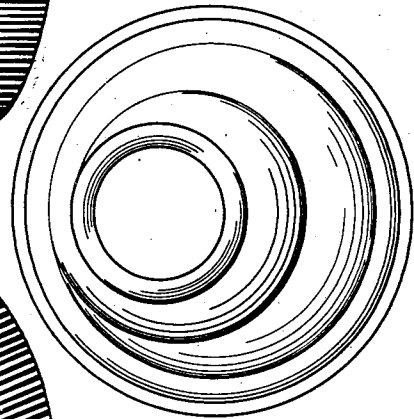

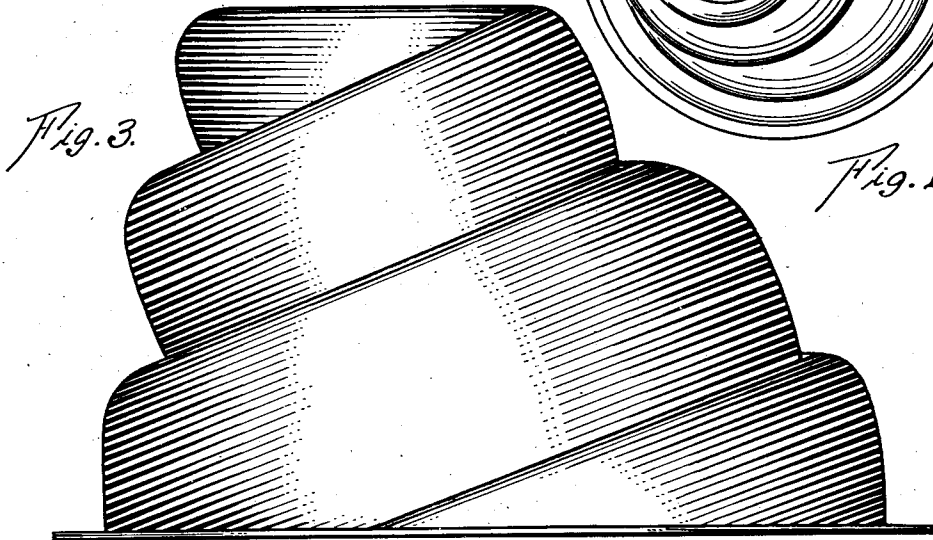

DESIGN FOR A LIGHTING FIXTURE

To all whom it may concern:

Be it known that I, John W. Morrison, a citizen of the United States of America, residing at Cincinnati, in the county of Hamilton, State of Ohio, have invented a new, original, and ornamental Design for a Lighting Fixture, of which the following is a specification, reference being had to the accompanying drawing forming part thereof.

Fig. 1 is a top plan view of the lighting fixture, showing my new design.

Fig. 2 is an enlarged side elevational view thereof.

Fig. 3 is an enlarged side elevational view thereof, showing the side opposite that shown in Fig. 2.
