

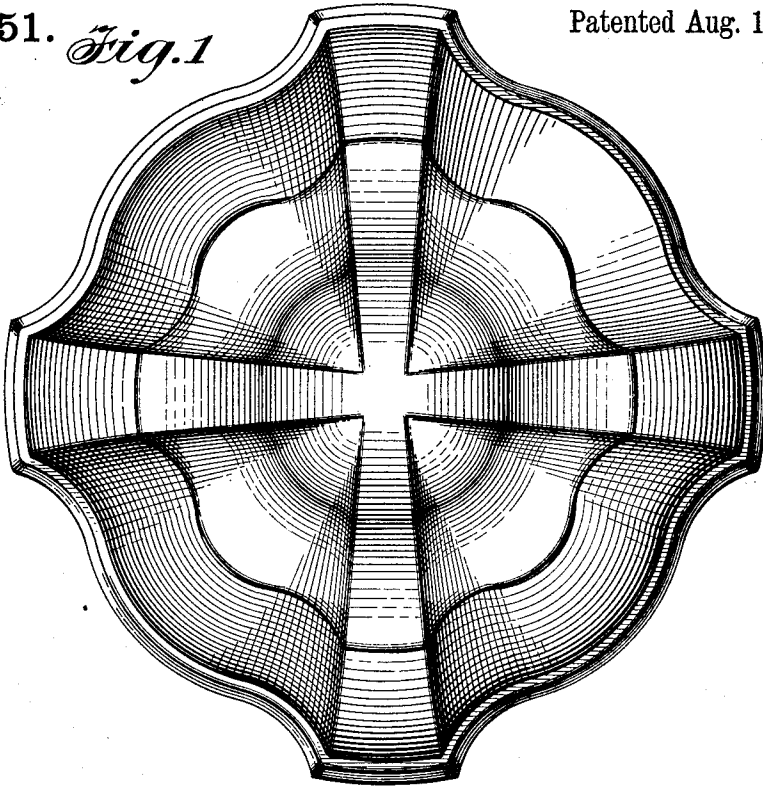

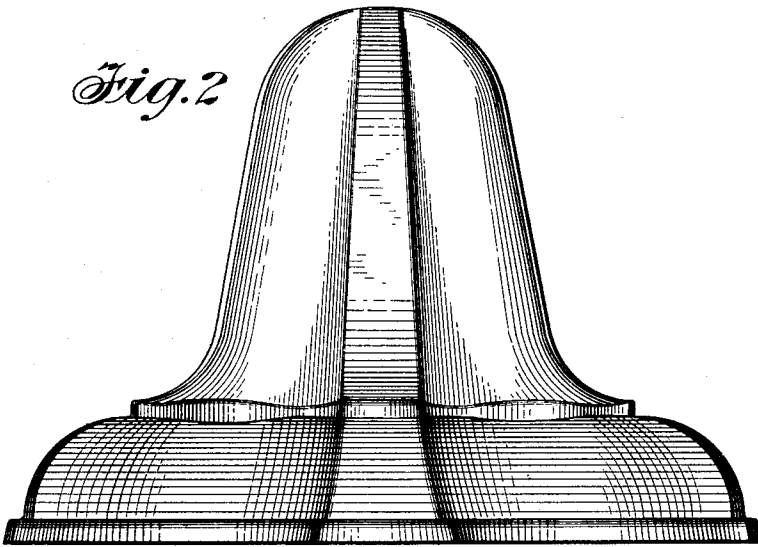

*To all whom it may concern:*

Be it known that I, EDWIN L. WHITE, a citizen of the United States, residing at the borough of Brooklyn, in the county of Kings and State of New York, have invented a new, original, and ornamental Design for a Canopy, of which the following is a specification, reference being had to the accompanying drawing, forming part thereof.
