

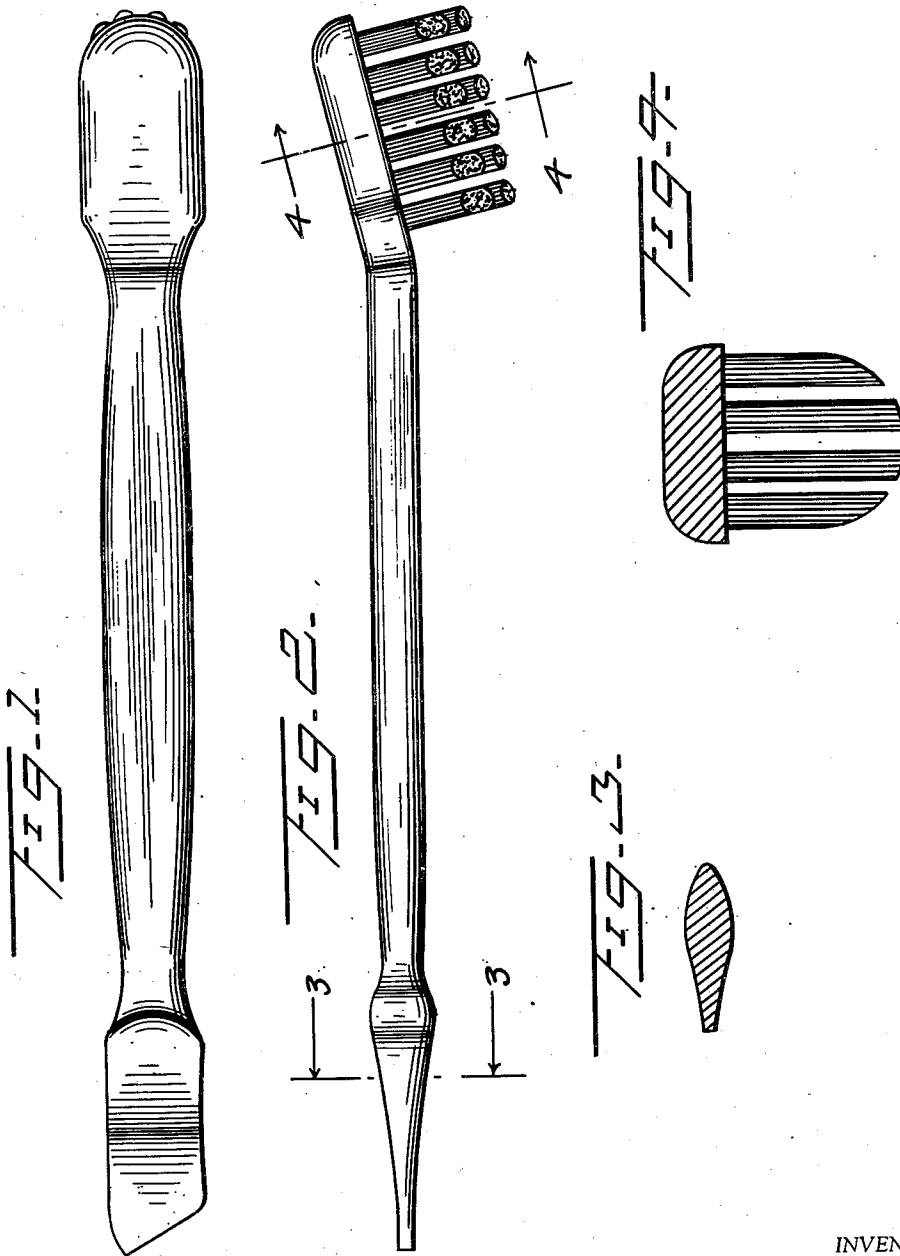

To all whom it may concern:

Be it known that I, Clarence Davis Ehrman, a citizen of the United States, residing at 214 South Sycamore Street in the city of Petersburg, State of Virginia, have invented a new, original, and ornamental Design for a Combined Denture Brush, Scraper, and Powder Adapter, of which the following is a specification, reference being had to the accompanying drawing, forming a part hereof.

Figure 1 is a plan view of a combined denture brush, scraper, and powder adapter, showing my new design;

Figure 2 is a side elevational view thereof;

Figure 3 is a cross-sectional view thereof, taken on line 3—3 in Figure 2; and

Figure 4 is a cross-sectional view thereof, taken on line 4—4 in Figure 2.

I claim:

The ornamental design for a combined denture brush, scraper, and powder adapter, as shown.
