FIG. 1 is a front elevation view of a construction permit storage device showing my new design;

FIG. 2 is a rear elevation view thereof;

FIG. 3 is a frontal right perspective view thereof;

FIG. 4 is a reduced scale frontal left perspective view thereof;

FIG. 5 is an enlarged fragmentary view of FIG. 4;

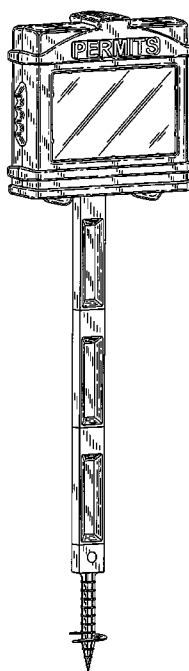

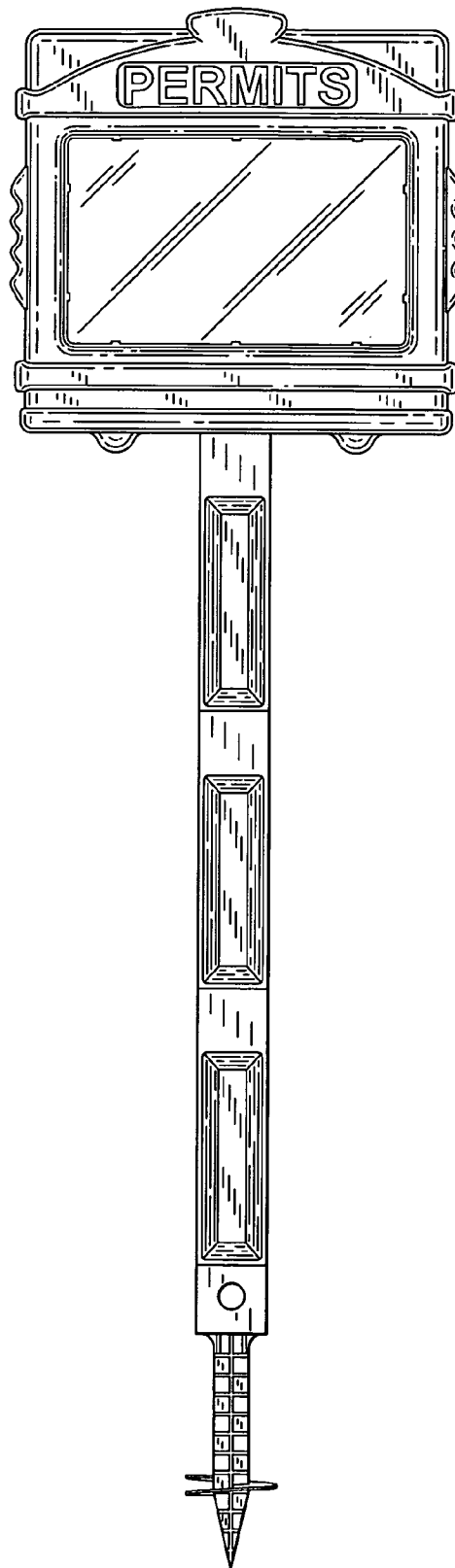

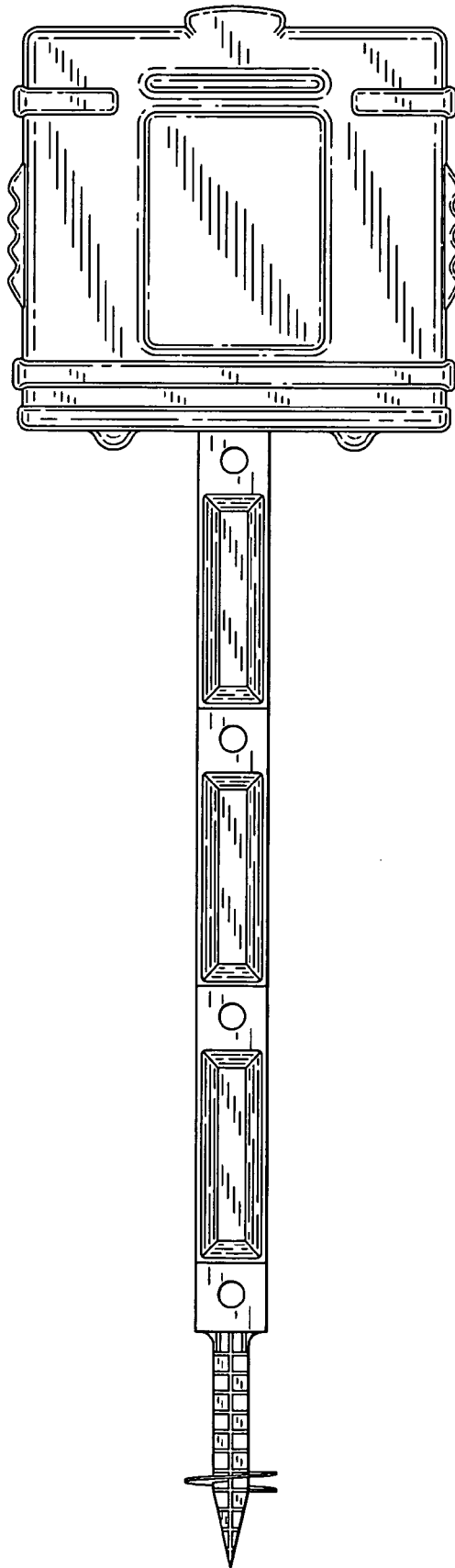

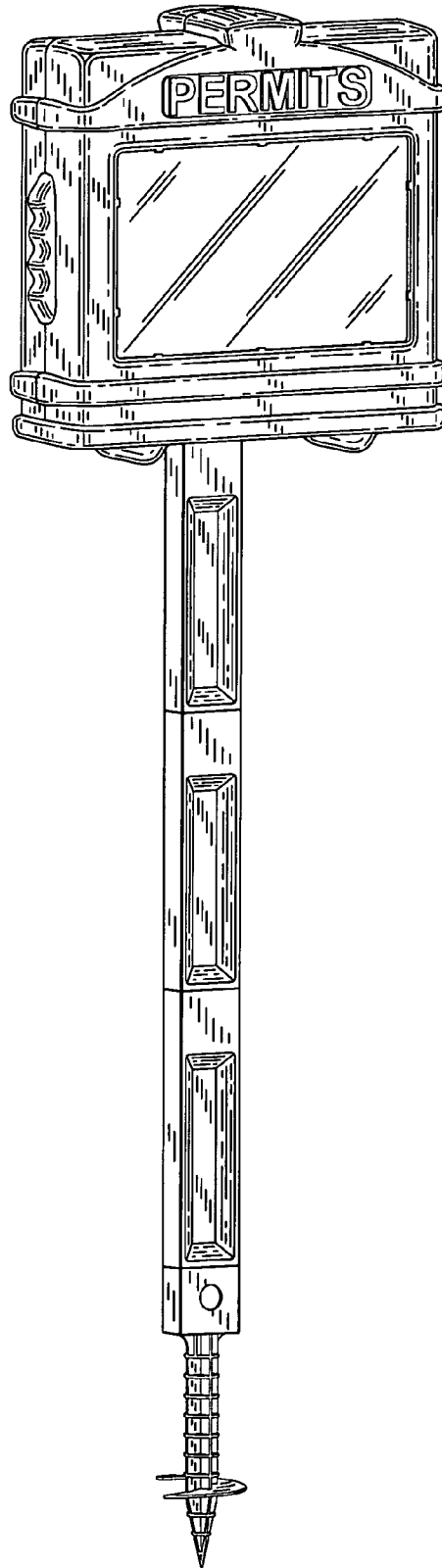

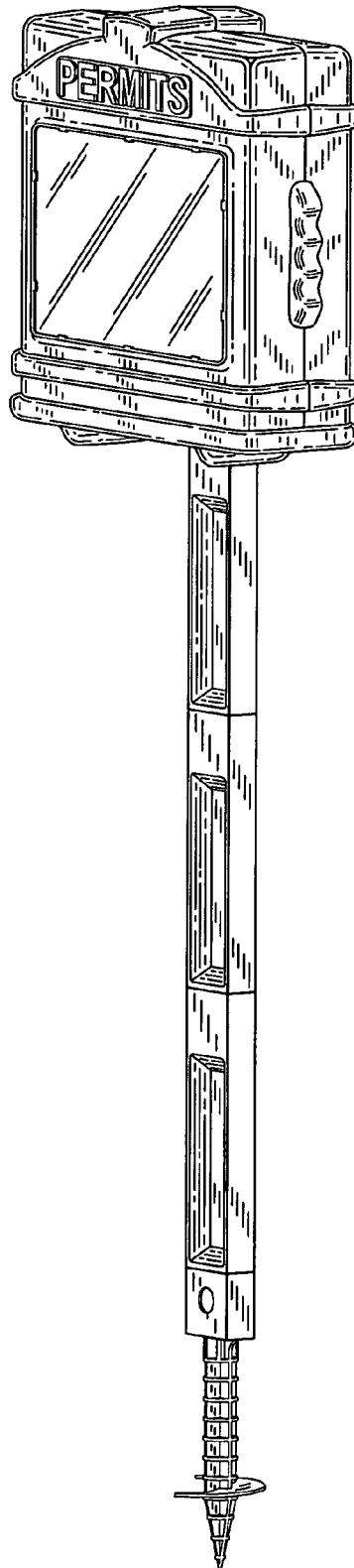

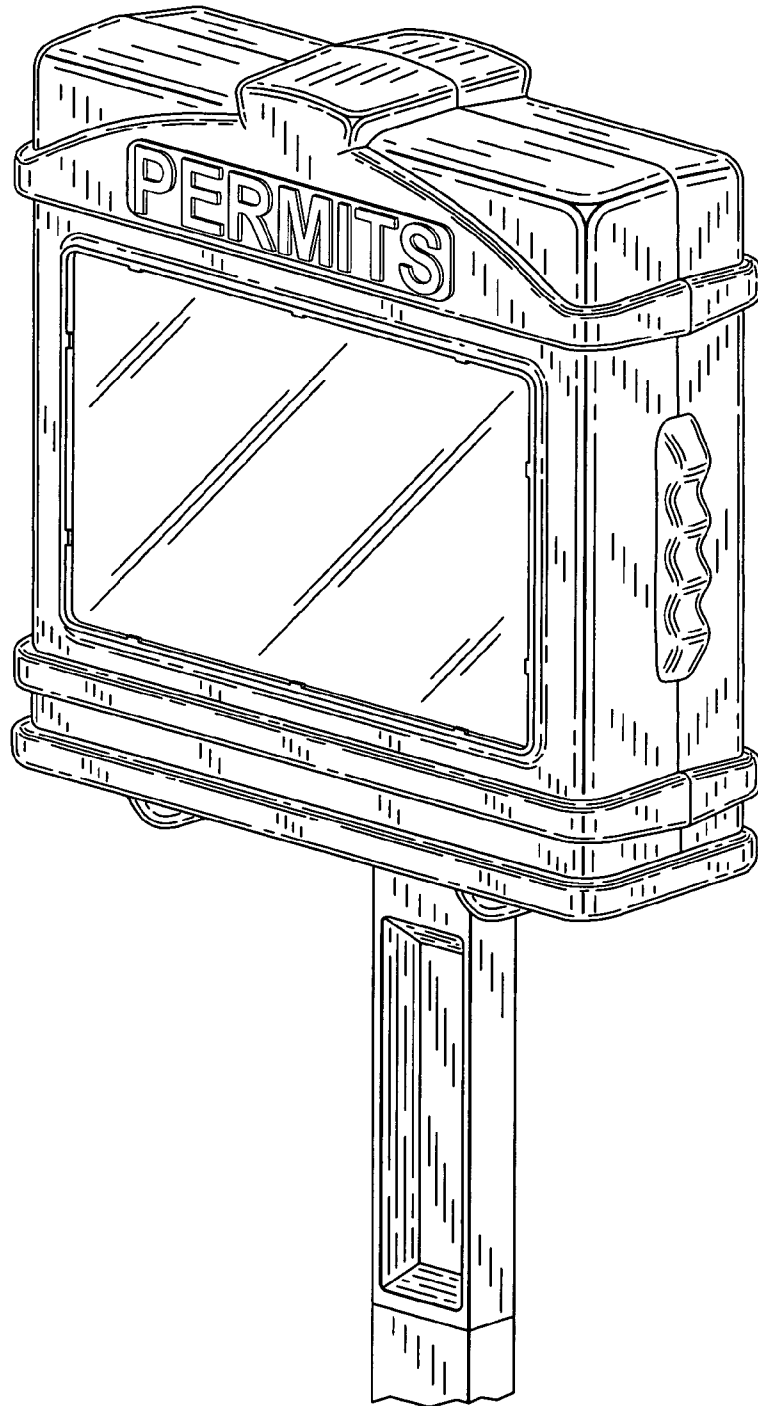

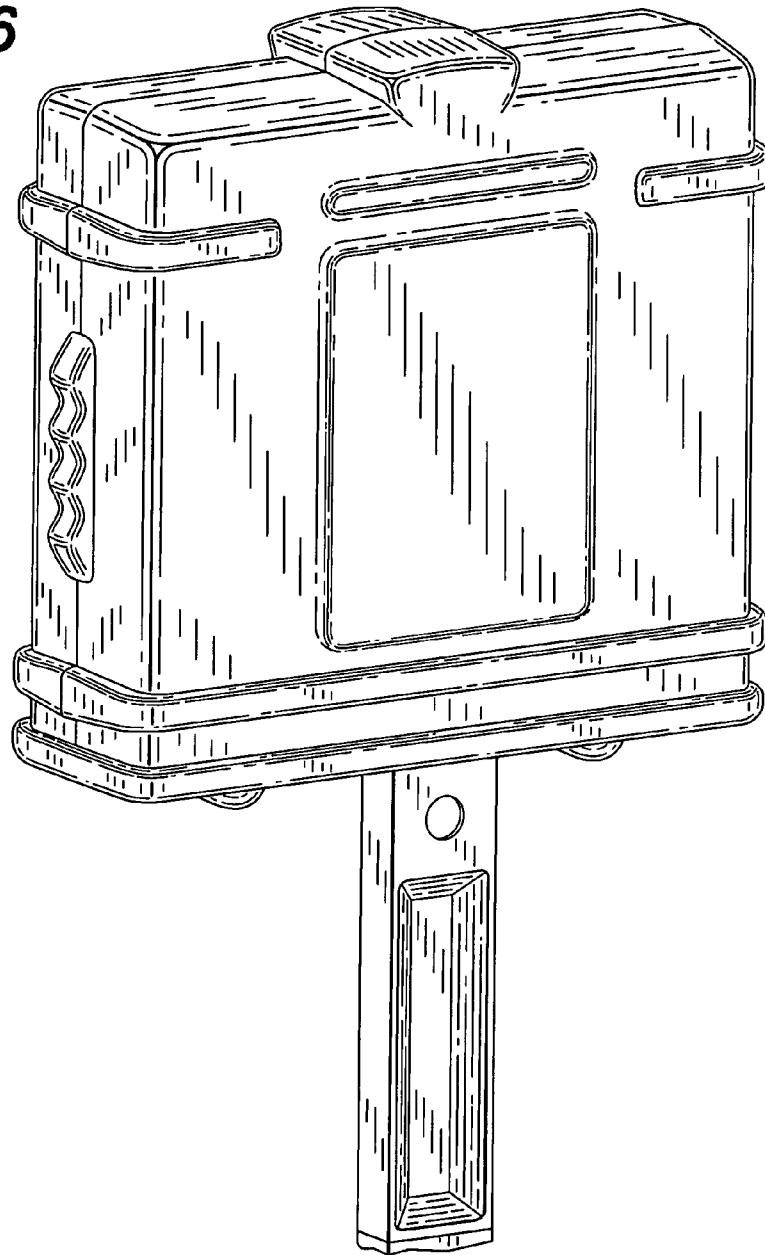

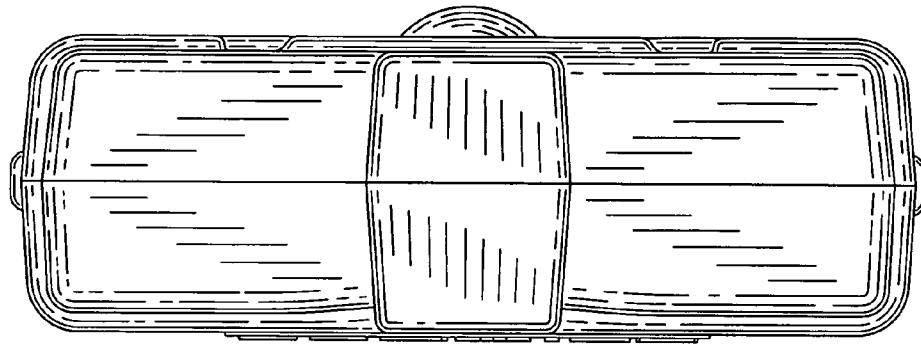

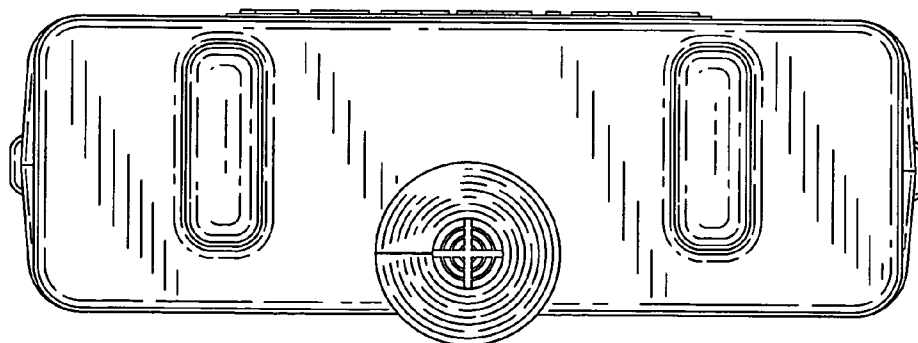

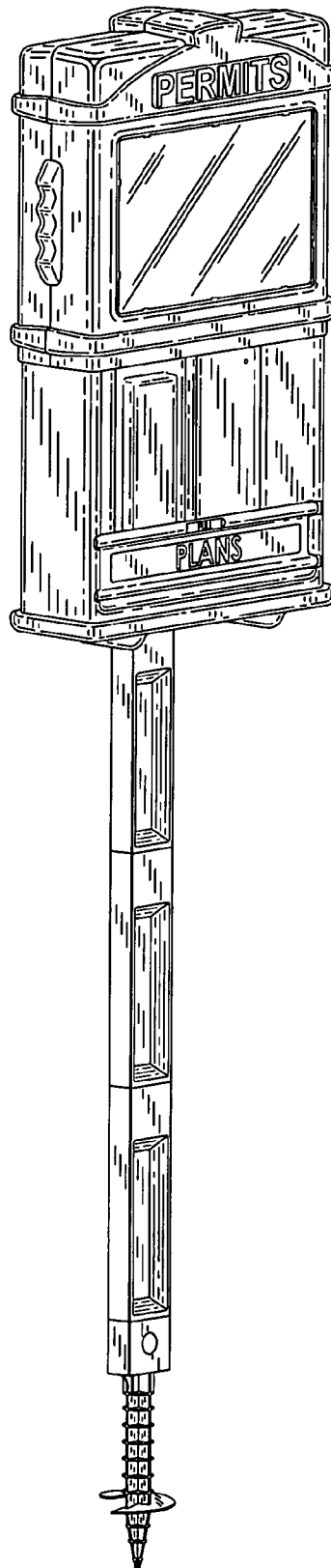

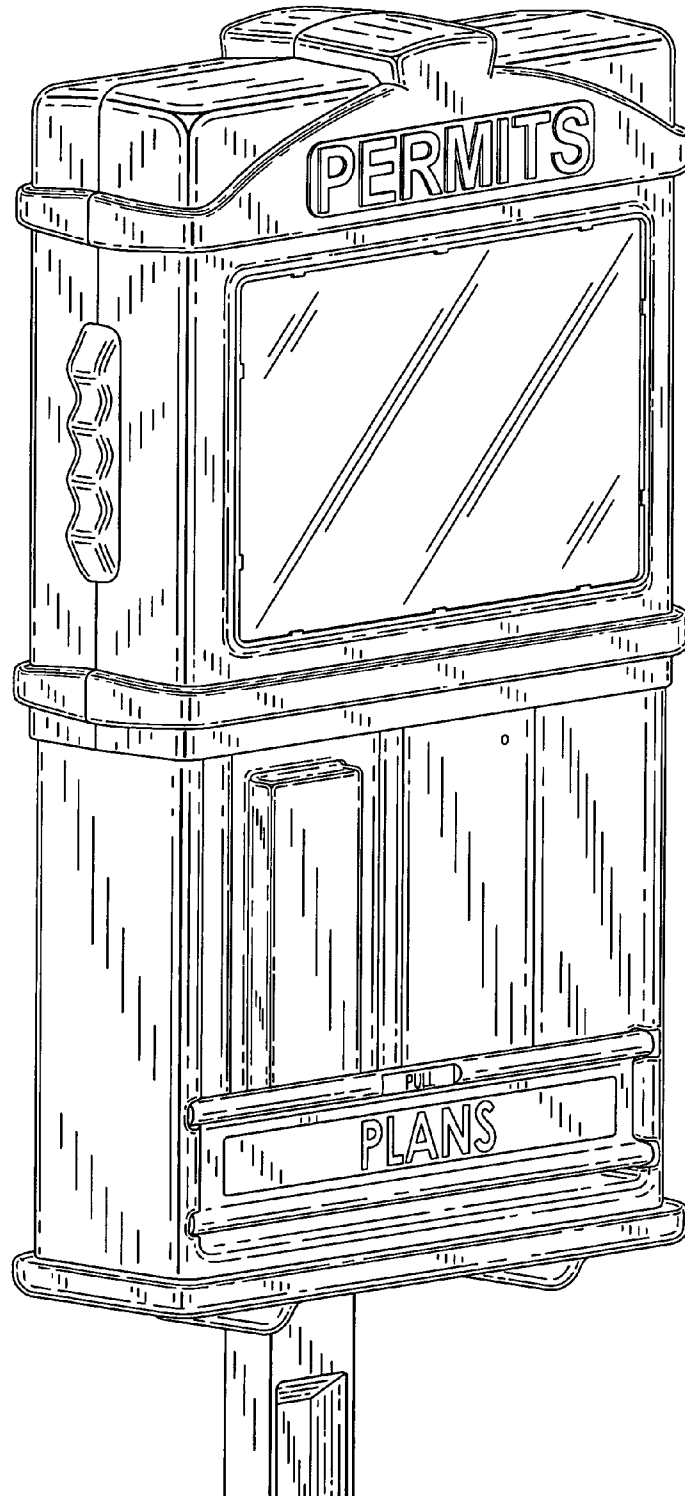
