

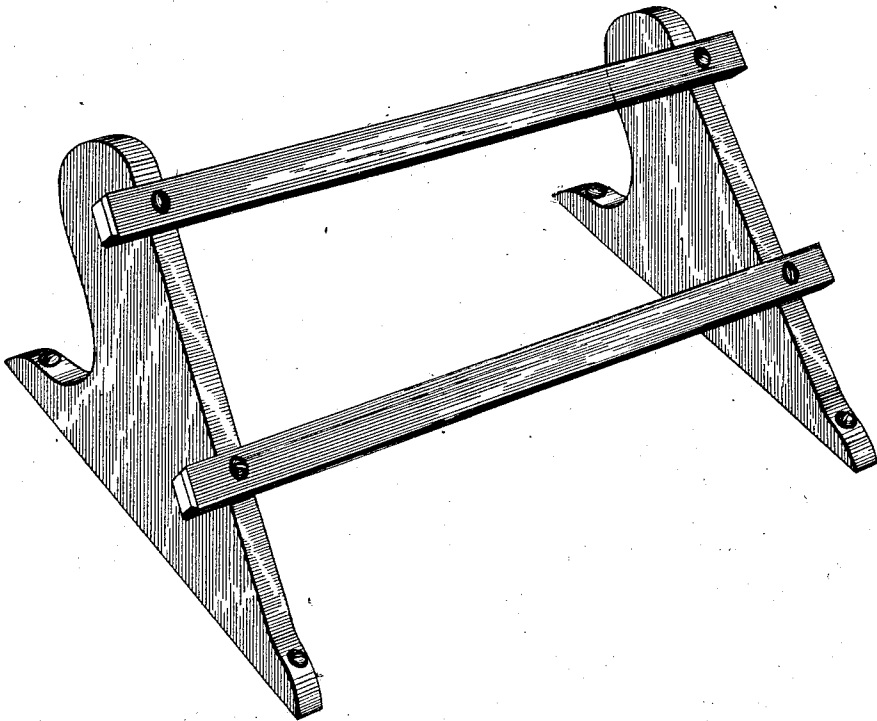

DESIGN FOR A SHOE RACK.

Application filed July 3, 1922. Serial No. 2,931. Term of patent 7 years.

To all whom it may concern:
