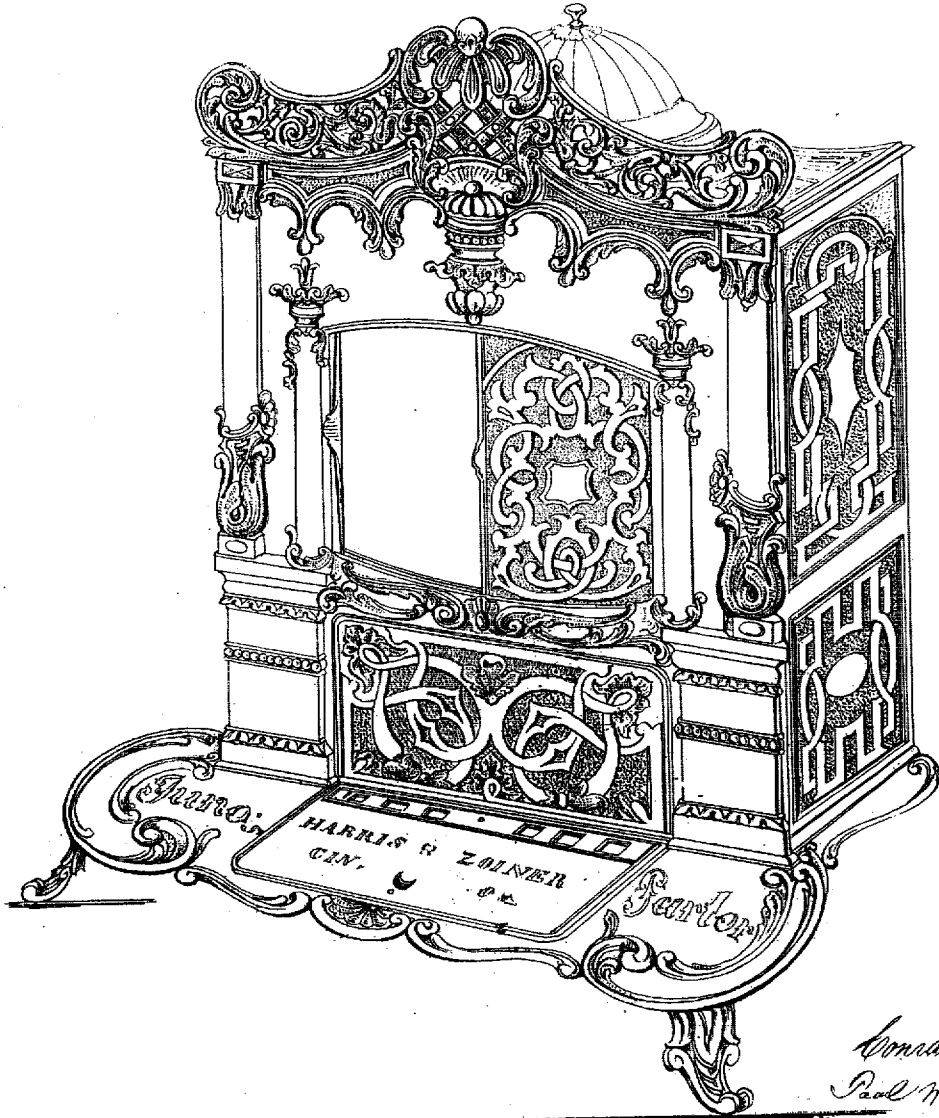

What we claim as our invention is the combination of the scrolls & foliage, arranged as set forth in the annexed drawings so as to form an ornamental design for Coal & Wood Parlor Stoves, to be known and called the Suns Parlor.
