DESIGN FOR A SODA-WATER FOUNTAIN.

The Schedule referred to in these Letters Patent and making part of the same.

Be it known that I, CHARLES W. ANDERSON, of the city of Cincinnati, and State of Ohio, have originated and designed a new Pattern for Soda-Water Fountains, of which the following is a full, clear, and exact description, reference being had to the accompanying drawings, making part of the specification.

The design consists in joining together two globes by the old mode of flanges or hollow casting, making a depression in the centre of the design, thus producing substantially as stated.

Claim.

What I claim as my invention, and desire to secure by Letters Patent, is—

The design for a soda-fountain herein set forth, and shown in the accompanying drawings.
